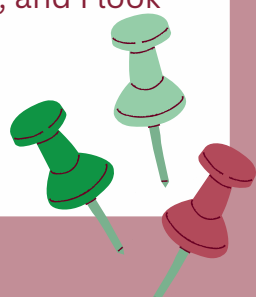
## Welcome
