Gheobhaidh tú eolas mar gheall ar do pháiste agus trialacha caighdeánaithe ar an suíomh greasáin www.ncca.ie agus ar www.gsnp.ie. Tá sé rí-thábhachtach an t-eolas a léamh mar freagrófar aon cheisteanna a bheadh agat ann. De réir treoirínte na Roinne faoin Straitéis Náisiúnta chun an Litearthacht agus an Uimhearthacht a Fheabhsú caithfidh gach bunscoil na trialacha a chur ar na daltaí i Rang 2, 4 agus 6 sa samhradh gach bliain.

Inár scoil cuirtear trialacha i nGaeilge, Béarla agus Matamaitice ar na daltaí ar fad ó Rang 1-6. Déanann na Naíonáin Mhóra trialacha i nGaeilge amháin. Cuirfear torthaí na dtrialacha abhaile chuig gach tuismitheoir roimh dheireadh na scoilbhliana sa tuairisc scoile.

Níl sna trialacha caighdeánaithe ach foinse amháin eolais mar gheall ar dhul chun cinn do pháiste sa léitheoireacht Bhéarla, sa mhatamaitic agus sa léitheoireacht i nGaeilge. Bíonn an múinteoir ag bailiú eolais mar gheall ar fhoghlaim do pháiste an t-am ar fad. Déanfaidh do pháiste na trialacha caighdeánaithe ar ghnáthlá scoile mar chuid dá g(h)náthobair sa seomra ranga. Go deimhin, d'fhéadfadh sé tarlú nach dtabharfaidh do pháiste faoi deara fiú go bhfuil trialacha á ndéanamh aici/aige.

Please find information relating to your child and standardised testing and scoring on www.ncca.ie and on www.gsnp.ie. It is vital to read the information as it should answer any queries you may have. According to the department's National Strategy to Improve Numeracy and Literacy among Children and Young People every primary school must test children in May or June each year in Rang 2, 4, agus 6.

In our school the children are tested in Irish reading, English reading and in maths from Rang 1 to Rang 6 every year. The Senior Infants are tested in Irish only. This year the standardised scores will be shared with parents on the end of year school report which you will receive before we break up for the summer.

Standardised tests are one source of information about your child's achievement in English reading, maths and Irish reading. The teacher gathers information about your child's learning all the time. Your child will take the standardised tests on a regular school day as part of his/her daily work in the classroom. Indeed, your child may not even realise he/she has taken the tests!
