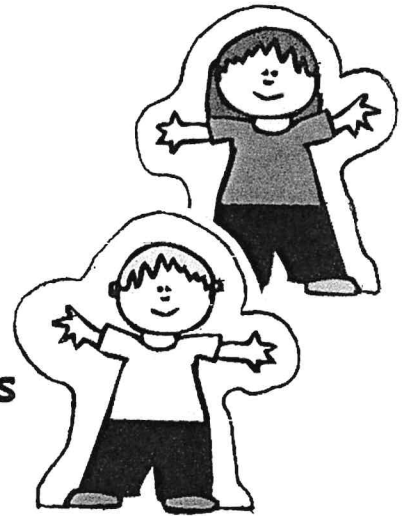
He didn't make ANYONE perfect in every detail. Perhaps this was so that we could more easily accept ourselves .. and accept other people. What do you think ?

Touching My Body

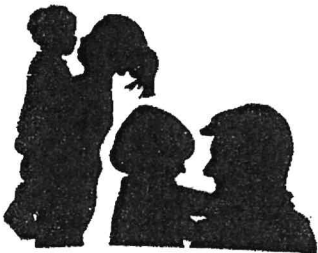
I'm in charge

a cuddle from mum/dad



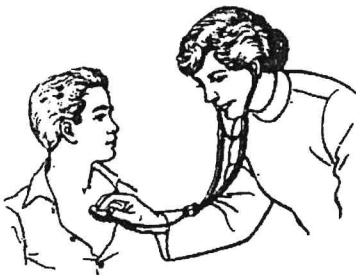
a kiss from grandma

If you don't like the way someone is touching you ... you need to tell a person who can help.

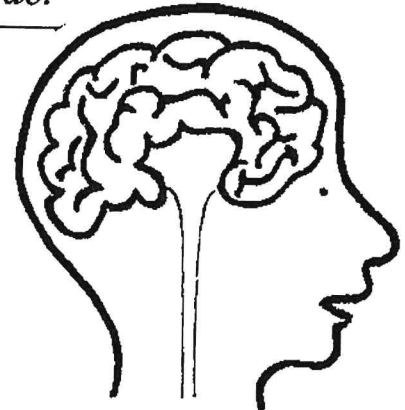
“Disciplining” My Body

(Crikey ~ the words in this book are getting bigger!!!)

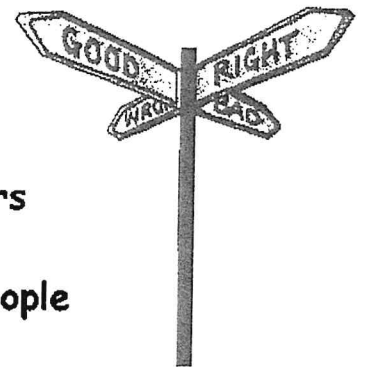
*It means being in full control of my body

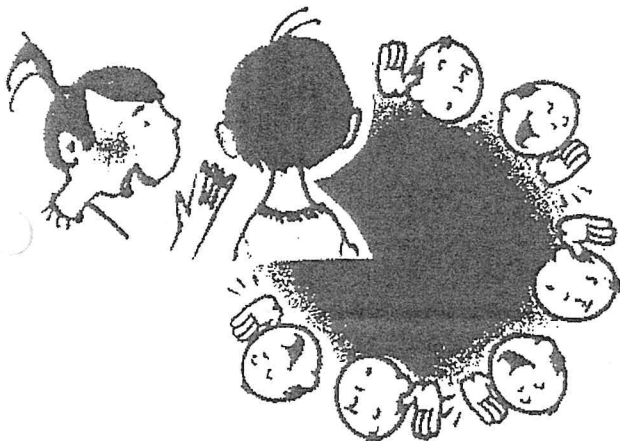

~ it's NOT funny !!!

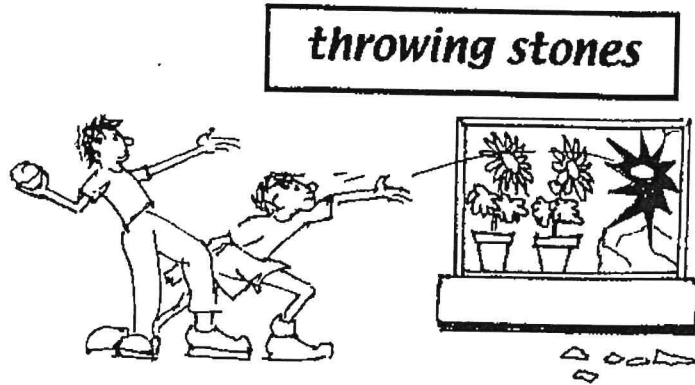

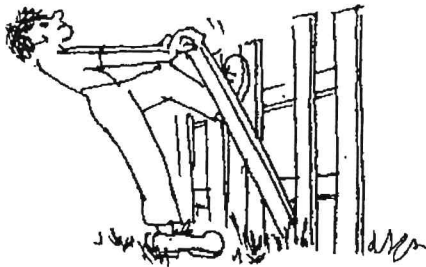
