Please find attached a list of activities for after school which will run up to October Half-Term and a few notes about our clubs this term.

- Clubs are divided up into P1-2, P3- 4 and P5 7 which allows us to operate clubs safely where attendance can be high and also where sporting clubs are taking place, to ensure risks are kept to a minimum when younger pupils are playing with older pupils.

 again this is for your child's safety. This is essential for football and hockey. Matches will be
 organised for both football and hockey teams so please continue to ensure regular attendance at
 both clubs. We welcome back Dwayne as our football coach and also appreciate Mrs Crooks and the
 hard work and dedication of both to coaching our children in these areas.
- Art and Craft continues to be offered as it is a popular club with the boys and girls. Art and Craft will
 be taken by Mrs Clarke and will feature lots of creative ideas. Cookery is also on offer again for P5 –
 7 children as this is a popular club too. The children enjoy making lots of tasty creations! Both great
 clubs for kids who enjoy practical crafty and creative activities.
- Please note that cycling Proficiency is for P6 and 7 children only. At this club, children will learn the skills to ride a bike safely on the road and will earn a certificate upon completing the course.
