Dear Everybody

Our school uniform is an important part of our identity, it is proven to promote inclusion, improve concentration and fosters our focus on promoting learning.

Most parents support our uniform policy and ensure that their child has the correct jumpers, trousers and shoes. Unfortunately, in recent times I have noticed that not all children are coming into school in the correct uniform. All our staff will be having a sharper focus on uniform and I wanted to remind you of our expectations.

Our school uniform consists of:

PURPLE: purple and white check dresses, sweatshirts/sweat cardigans with official logo

WHITE: shirts, blouses, polo shirts, socks, tights

GREY: skirts, pinafore dresses, trousers, shorts, socks, tights

BLACK: shoes

Please do not send your child into school in jogging trousers, colourful trainers/shoes and hooded tops. If your child comes to school in wellies or boots, please bring a change of shoes for your child to swap into.

Please be aware we do have a small number of children who wear an alternative uniform, due to their sensory needs and these have been agreed by Mrs O'Neill or myself. If you think your child will have an issue with wearing the correct uniform please come and speak to us.
