



Extra Covid-related measures at SNS

At the start of the Nursery year session times will be variable. This is normal during the 'Settling In' period. We will build up gradually to our bubble of 26. Your child's teacher will keep you informed of times each week.

We would appreciate you taking note of the following important information in relation to Restart. These measures are consistent with the latest guidance produced by the Department of Education and the Public Health Agency.

- After first days of 'Settling In' parents/adults will not ordinarily be able to enter the classrooms.
- **IF** coming into the school premises – please use hand sanitiser provided.
- In the **mornings** Mrs Gillespie's class will enter through the main front door.
- In the **mornings** Mrs Cunningham's class will enter through the green playground gates to access Mrs Cunningham's playground door.
- In the morning - please hang up your child's 'Home Coat' on the named rails & hangers provided. Thank you.
- Children can bring only themselves into the classroom and no items from home at this time.
- Both classes will be collected at **home time** from their playground doors.
- Please maintain safe distancing. There are markings to guide you.
- To minimise the need to queue, please arrive at the appropriate times.
- The classroom door will open just before pick up time.
- **All adults need to adhere strictly to the session times given.** These have been **staggered to allow for social distancing**.
- **Your children MUST always be kept beside you.** They are not allowed to use the playground equipment. This is one of our infection control measures. The two classes will have separate periods of supervised outdoor play where we will be using zones and rotation to mitigate risk of transmission.
