Please find below, a rather long but I believe necessary note to explain what will be happening over the next few weeks. This is only a guideline and as we have learnt things can change at a rapid pace, however to keep a little structure in place for all the following pieces of schoolwork will be made available for Rang 3 children on a weekly basis.

1. **Taisce Tuisceanna-Scéal, Ceisteanna agus Audio.**

A Taisce Tuisceanna passage will be made available on a weekly basis. Your child is familiar with the question and answer format. An audio attachment will accompany Taisce Tuisceanna every week. It can be found at the very bottom of the webpage for the particular week.



2. **Leitheoireacht** - Ar fáil ar Google Classroom.

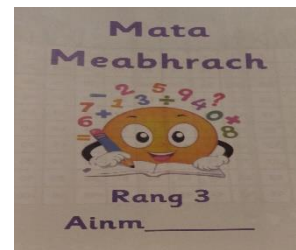
Irish reading material will be posted on Google Classroom each week. If you have not already received log in instructions please contact armaghcbcs2020@gmail.com for further assistance.

3. **Fónaic/Linguistic Phonics** - We continue our phonic journey with alternate Irish & English weeks. I will upload two levels, you know which group you were in - Make sure you read the words, make sentences and spot those patterns in your reading books!



I am not testing you each Friday - but this will happen when we return so be sure to practice!!

4. **Mata Meabhrach** - We will continue to complete our New Wave Mental Maths from Monday to Friday. Answers to these questions will be posted each Friday. This week we will begin on page 50.



5. **Sumdog**. A weekly challenge will be set. It will run from 9am each Monday and will finish at 3pm on Friday.



Remember to encourage your child to reach his/her target whilst striving to attain a high degree of accuracy. Children will practice a range of mathematical skills including Number, Shape & Space, Time and Graph work etc.

6. **Mata** - Leatanaigh Oibre/Fisean/Cluiche. Worksheets will be provided for the purposes of revision and further learning. There may be a range of differentiated material so choose which one suits you best. Clips from YouTube and interactive games may be posted here in the coming weeks to help and support your learning.



7. **Nessy**. You know the importance we attach to Nessy in this the first year of formally learning English. It has become even more of an invaluable resource to us from we left school so suddenly back in March. Keep it going! You will get your star from me when you have completed 60 mins, but to get a special message and shout out from Mr Breen you must hit 100 mins! That's 20 minutes per day from Monday to Friday! (You can also gain time at the weekends!)

8. **Béarla** - Two levels of comprehension will be given per week. Choose the one which best suits your ability. There is a learning outcome attached to each comprehension. This shall include a range of fiction and non-fiction text, development of phonetical awareness, elements of grammar whilst continually developing oral language. AR is also available for those wishing to use it during 'normal' school hours.



Please remember at all stages to enjoy your learning journey. If you have not got a printer or you do not get your work completed on allocated days do not worry. Any work which you see online may be simply copied into you leabhar gorm, or any other notebook you wish to use. Be sure to
