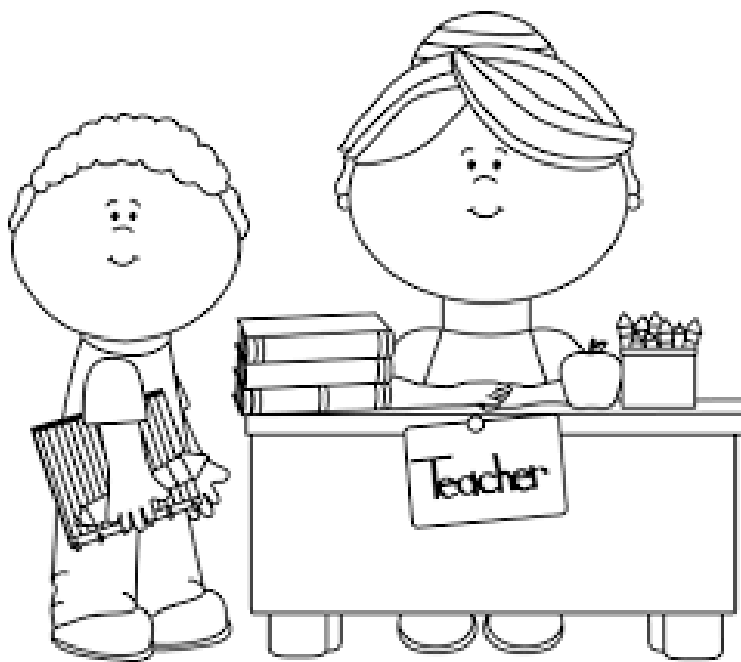

	Literacy/Phonics	Teaching Instructions	Numeracy	Teaching Instructions
Monday	Phonics: Syllables (cut and stick) Extension: Write sentences using words made.	Children to cut and stick the syllables to make the word that matches the picture. E.g. "Sev" "en"	Number: Matching number words.	Children to work within 30. Matching word to number.
Tuesday	Phonics: Double "ll" sound. Extension: Write sentences using 'll' words.	Children to make words using the diagraph "ll" from the picture into the sound squares.	Money: Adding 1p, 2p and 5p to make amounts.	Children to add total amounts of money.
Wednesday	Topic: Pets (WAU) Match pets to homes.	Closed Procedure worksheet. Children to fill in the missing adjective and pets home. Explain to children that an adjective is a describing word. This is a new concept as we haven't covered this yet.	Number: Numbers within 30. Draw 30 flowers in the Spring Garden.	Revise with children numbers up to and including 30.
Thursday	Topic: Pets (WAU) Write a shopping list of items that a pet of your choice will need. Extension: Draw your pet at the bottom of the shopping list.	Use word mat to assist children in writing a list. Children to write in list format, not as sentences.	Data Handling: Pet Bar Graph.	Using the information in the key to create a bar graph of pets from our class.
Friday	Parent led Spelling Test and Numeracy/Maths target.	Test the children on the spellings and target set at the beginning of the week.	Online Games and activities	Use the list of recommended online games/apps/websites to reinforce learning. See note in previous pack.
