## Hf word Games: Bowling



For this game, you will need some bowling skittles or paper cups, a ball, sticky labels or paper and cello tape, markers or pencils.

On the paper or labels, write some Hf words that you would like to practise reading and recognising. These words can be found in coloured lists in the Hf word folder of my home learning page. e.g. you could start with 6 words and then progress to 10 (as seen in the photo).

Then, you place the skittles in their traditional

triangular pattern, but the choice is up to you.

Standing a few feet away, you roll the ball and try to knock down the skittles or cups.

You score one point for every one you knock down as long as you can read the word on it!

You can play as many rounds as you like, until you can read all the words quickly and without sounding across. Once you can do that, you can select different words over and over again.

This is also a fun game to play outside in your garden!
