



All you need for this game is some paper, Post- Its and coloured pencils or markers. You could use a whiteboard or a chalk easel like the one in the picture but it's not essential. On the paper, writing across the page, pick some Hf words that you would like to practise reading and recognising. These words can be found in coloured lists in the Hf word folder of my home learning page.

We now need to make a grid of these words. You need to write each word twice in this grid because you will be trying to find matching pairs.

e.g. you could start with 4 rows of 3 words. That's 12 words in total but 6 pairs of words. These are pink level words but you can select whatever level you need to learn.

(the/the) (and/and) (my/my) (went/went) (like/like) (is/is)

Eg.

the	and	and
my	is	went
like	went	the
like	is	my

You may want to start with 6 words total but 3 pairs of words. (3 rows of 2 or 2 rows of 3 words). You can decide to start with less words and then build these up to greater numbers (as seen in the photo).

Then, you cover the words with Post- Its or if you're working on flat piece of paper just cover the words with whatever you have.

Taking turns with a partner, you take away two Post- Its at a time. You MUST read the words which have been uncovered. If you find a matching pair and can read them you get a point!

The player with most points when all words have been uncovered and matched wins the game!
