## Amazing Fact

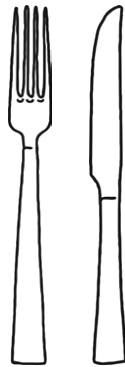
The order in which cutlery was made and commonly used, from the oldest invention to the most recent, was the spoon, then then knife, then the fork.

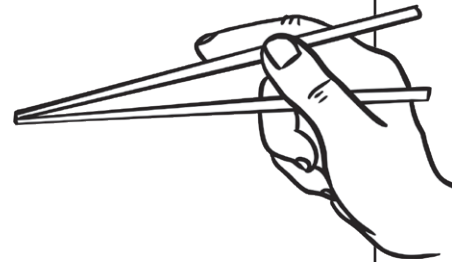
