

I am excited for you to share these QR Read Aloud codes with your class! My class loves them, I am sure yours will too!

To use, print the QR codes on the next pages and put them up in your classroom.

I love choice...so I gave you several choices to choose from!

- I have full color, partial color, and black & white for each choice.
- You can choose a full sheet of QR codes, or several small sheets.
- If you choose the full sheet...
 - It works best if you teach your kids how to cover the other QR codes while they scan the one they want. I put several on the sheet so that they had several choices. However, it can be tricky to scan the one you want if they are all visible.
 - This option can be easy to replace if I update the QR codes. You just toss the old sheet and put out the new one!
- If you choose the quarter sheets...
 - I have included cover choices. You can put the cards on a ring, or put them in a small box. with the covers.
 - You can also just give out one QR code at a time.
 - This one is a little harder to update but still not difficult. When I update the resource, I will let you know specifically which QR code I had to fix. That way, you can just remove the quarter with that one and replace it.

NEW QR READER UPDATE!

Most devices now make it much easier to read QR codes!

You no longer need an app...

Here's how:

- I. Open up your camera.
- 2. Hover your camera on top of the QR code (as if you were taking a picture of it.)
- 3. You can zoom in like you normally would if you are having trouble focusing on one particular code.
- 4. When your phone is hovering over the code, you will see a pop up at the top asking if you want to open the QR code in safari.
- 5. Click the pop up!


