

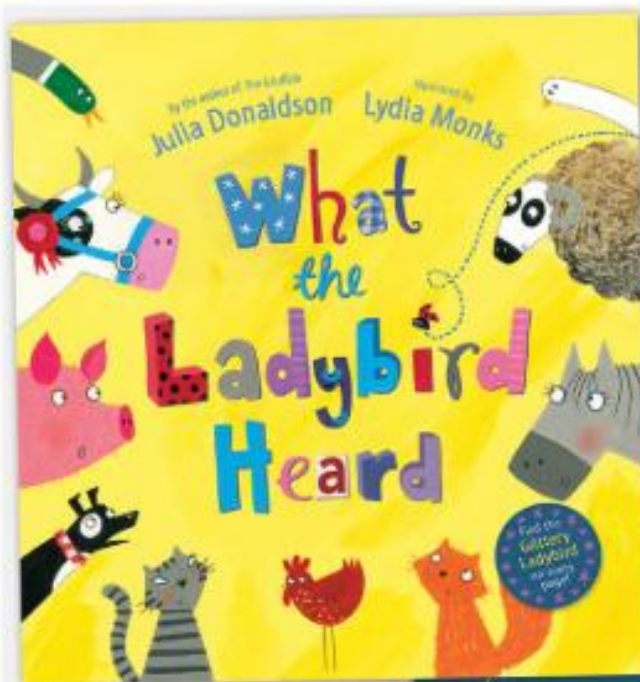


A Ready to read

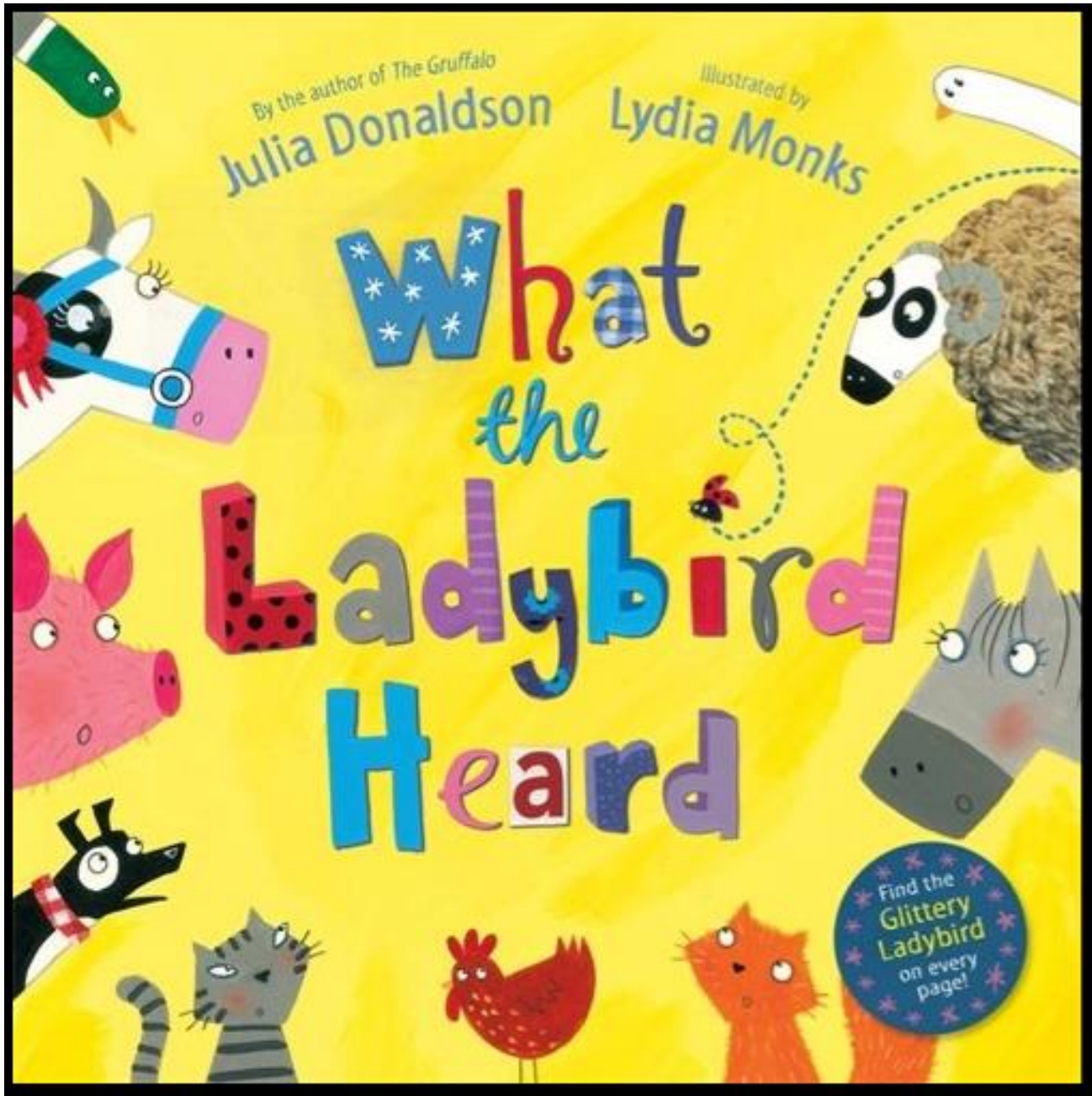
