## Peter Rabbit CVC Word Building Game

## Activity Guide

## You will need:

- Peter Rabbit Word Building Mat
- Carrot Vowel and Consonant Cut-Outs
- Sorting Posters
- Two containers (optional)


## The Activity

A fun phonics game for 2 players.
Begin by sorting the carrot cards into two sets - consonants and vowels, and place them into two piles or containers.

Then, give each player a Peter Rabbit Word Building Mat.
Take turns to choose two consonant carrot cards and one vowel carrot card. Arrange these on your mat to make a word. (Hint: Try placing the vowel in the middle!)

Sound out and blend the letters together to read the word you have created. If the carrots spell out a real word, then the carrots can be put onto the wheelbarrow poster. If the carrots do not spell out a real word, they can be put onto the compost bin poster!

Keep going until all of the carrots have been used.
How many words can you make?
