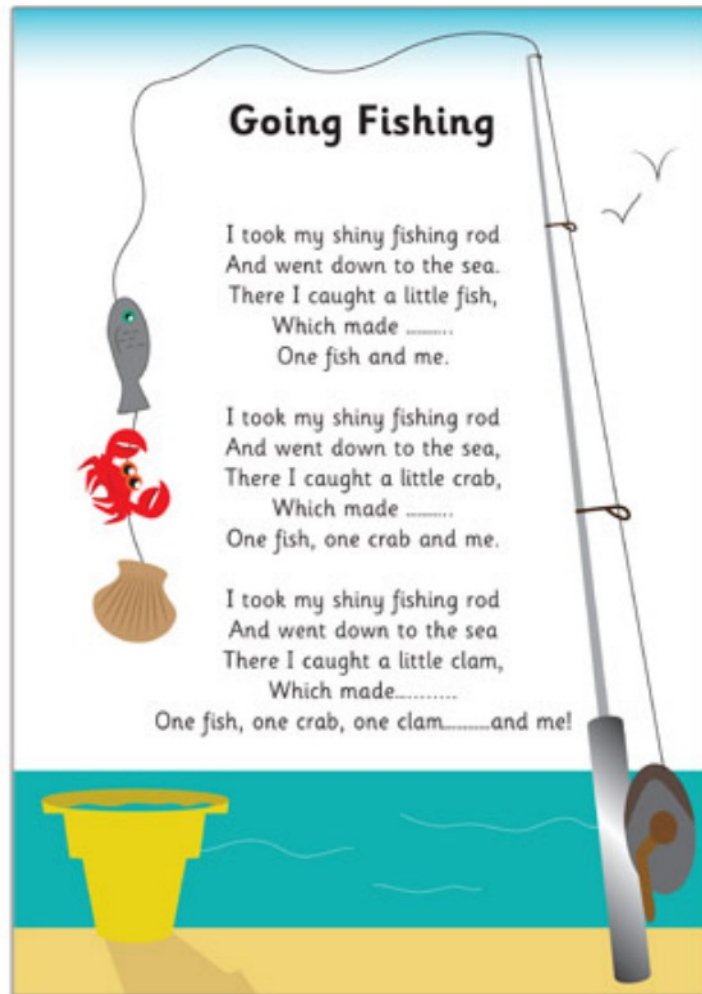


Enjoy listening to and reading these 4 Ocean poems.
