## Writing Office/Area

A writing office/area can be used at school or at home as a way to foster independence with children's writing. Students can reference the different learning materials inside the office as they are practicing their writing. Plus, students love the privacy aspect of creating their own space.



\*\*\*To assemble I use two manila folders and glue them together on the edge. I glue the pages down and then laminate for durability. You could also use a cardboard box or sheet of cardboard.

## What's included?

I have gathered together some materials which you may like to download and add to your writing area.

- Writing Area title (this can be designed by the child or use the printed posters provided
- Alphabet Letters/sounds
- Number Words (1-20 and 1-99)
- Colours
- Hf Words (these can be printed out from the high frequency post on my home learning page and be changed as a child progresses or all can be included in your writing office)
- Or I've also included an editable Hf word template which you can use to put a variety of the coloured levelled words into if you wish

You could stick a poly pocket pouch onto your writing center and have a variety of Hf word lists inside.

- Weather word mat
- Days, months and Seasonal words
- Shapes
- Punctuation Chart
- Writing Checklist (Uppercase to start, finger spaces, punctuation)

Feel free to add your own special touches to your writing area. You can add drawings and stickers and decorate it with art materials.
