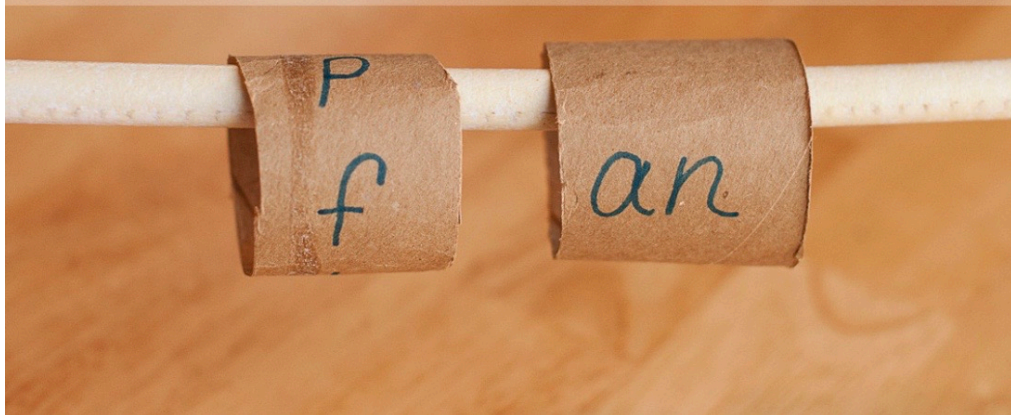


Rhyming Activity with a SPIN



Spin and Rhyme

Rhyming is a crucial literacy skill. Here is an easy activity to encourage rhyming, word families and also practises breaking down words phonetically.

You will need:

paper rolls

A spool (a chopstick, thick cord)

Scissors

markers

- Cut the paper roll into sections



- Write a two-sound ending (you can find examples from the word family poster in this folder)



- Now write some beginning or initial sounds on another piece of roll
You can usually add 6 initial sounds but you can have less at the beginning and build this up.





- Slide your tube pieces onto the rod.
Now you can spin the first sound and “make” and read lots of different rhyming words.
It might be fun to sing out the words or clap the sounds and dance.
