- Present your script no later than Monday 15th November to your Form Tutor
- Chosen scripts will be selected by the Senior Leadership Team
- Those chosen will be invited to be presented live to the Senior Leadership Team, your Form Tutors and Head of 6th Form
- You may be asked further questions about your topic and the process of creating your TED talk
- A winner will be chosen

House points will be awarded to all who participate and meet the requirements.
