Introduction: (10.00-10.20)

Opening Prayer: Scripture Reading and Reflection, Bishop Donal McKeown

Warm up: Holy Spirit Stretch

Activity 1: (10.20-11.00) **Baptism:** Our journey to God the Father with Jesus begins

Catechesis:

What is a sacrament? Why do we need sacraments? Accepting the gift of the sacrament of Baptism

Activity Resource: Called by God to Proclaim the Good News-people template.

To complete the task, use **Resource 1: Myself** (we have provided a number of choices for the children or they can simply draw their own image.)

Activity 2: (11.15-11.40) Eucharist: Food to live life well

Catechesis:

What is the gift of the Eucharist? Why do we need the Eucharist? How do we live the Eucharist in our daily lives?

Catechesis:


Exploring the link between Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation - Sacraments of Initiation

To complete the task use Resource 3: An Invitation from Jesus for discussion








Wednesday 8th January 2024 What is the Holy Spirit like?

Introduction: (10.00-10.20)

Welcome:

Opening Prayer; Scripture Reading and Reflection, Bishop Donal McKeown

Warm up: Holy Spirit Stretch

Activity 1: (10.20-11.00) And suddenly from heaven there came a sound . . .

Catechesis:

Jesus' whole life and mission was carried out in communion with the Holy Spirit. To understand the Holy Spirit, we can use three main symbols- wind, fire, and dove. Exploring the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives through the use of these symbols.

Activity Resource:

To complete the task, use Resource 1: Design and make a Holy Spirit Kite

BREAK (11.00-11.15)

Activity 2a: (11.15-11.40) If we are led by God's Spirit and open to the **gifts** that God gives us, the fruits of the Holy Spirit will be seen in everything we do.

Catechesis:

What are the gifts of the Holy Spirit?

Why did God give us the gifts of the Holy Spirit?

How can we use the gifts of the Holy Spirit to become disciples of Jesus filled with joy.

Activity Resource:

To complete the task, use Resource 2: Prayer and reflection asking God for the gift of the Holy Spirit you need most at this time in your life.

Activity 2b: (11.40-12.00) If we are led by God's Spirit and open to the gifts that God gives us the **fruits** of the Holy Spirit will be seen in everything, we do.

Catechesis:

Using the gifts of the Holy Spirit, people will see the fruits of the Holy Spirit in our lives.



Activity 1: (10.20-11.00) I have called you by your name, you are mine

In Baptism we are given the name God knows us by for all of our life
In Confirmation we take a new name as we take on more responsibility as a disciple of Jesus
Called for Mission-Biblical characters who were given new names as they were called by God

Qualities of a Saint

Activity 2: (11.15-11.40) Then Peter and John placed their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit. (Acts 8:17) Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the presence of his brothers, and from that day on the Spirit of the Lord came powerfully upon David. (1:Samuel 16:13)

Catechesis:

Prophets, kings and priests and prophets were anointed with oil as a sign of being strengthened by the Holy Spirit.

The Bishop will anoint the Confirmation candidate with the oil of Chrism also used at their Bpatism The name 'Christ' means 'anointed.' Jesus placed hands on people as a sign of healing or blessing. The apostles used the laying on of hands as a sign of the coming of the Holy Spirit (Acts 8:14-17) The Bishop/Priest lays hands on the Confirmation candidate as a sign of being chosen for Mission
