Unfortunately, our Education Authority funding is no longer enough to cover the cost of the very basic equipment that we require such as paper, paint, toilet roll etc. Therefore, your support in contributing a small amount each month really does go a long way in supporting your child in their 'whole' pre-school education. Aside from the subsidised 'Pantomime' visit, we try not to ask parents to pay for anything else throughout the year.
