"Wait!" I say. "The right piece could be here somewhere. If you un-snooze Scoot, we could all tidy up and find it."

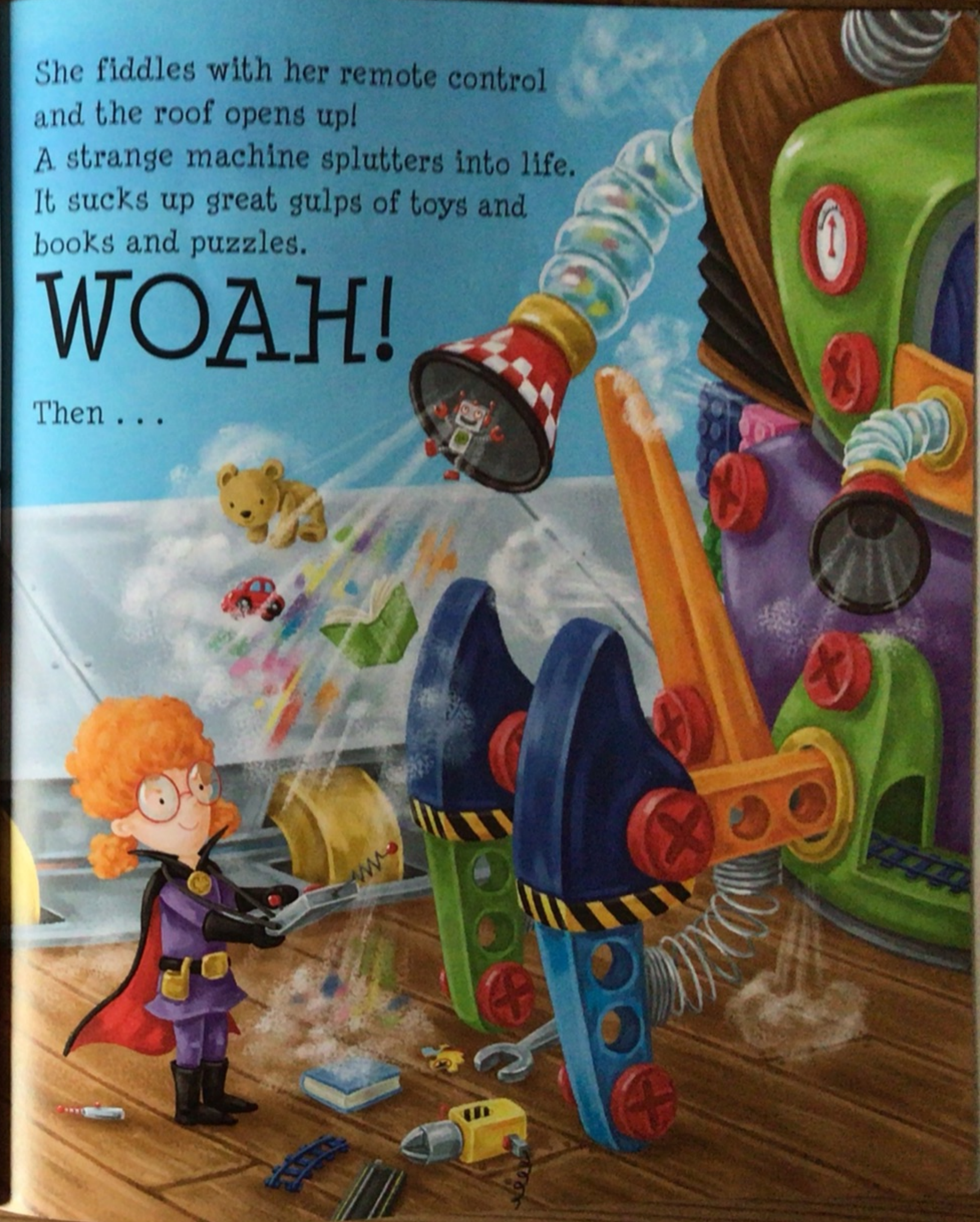


"I don't need your help!" growls The Collector. "Watch this."

The machine shoots the toys back out, straight onto shelves and into drawers and tubs. "A Toy Tidier!" I gasp. **AWESOME!**



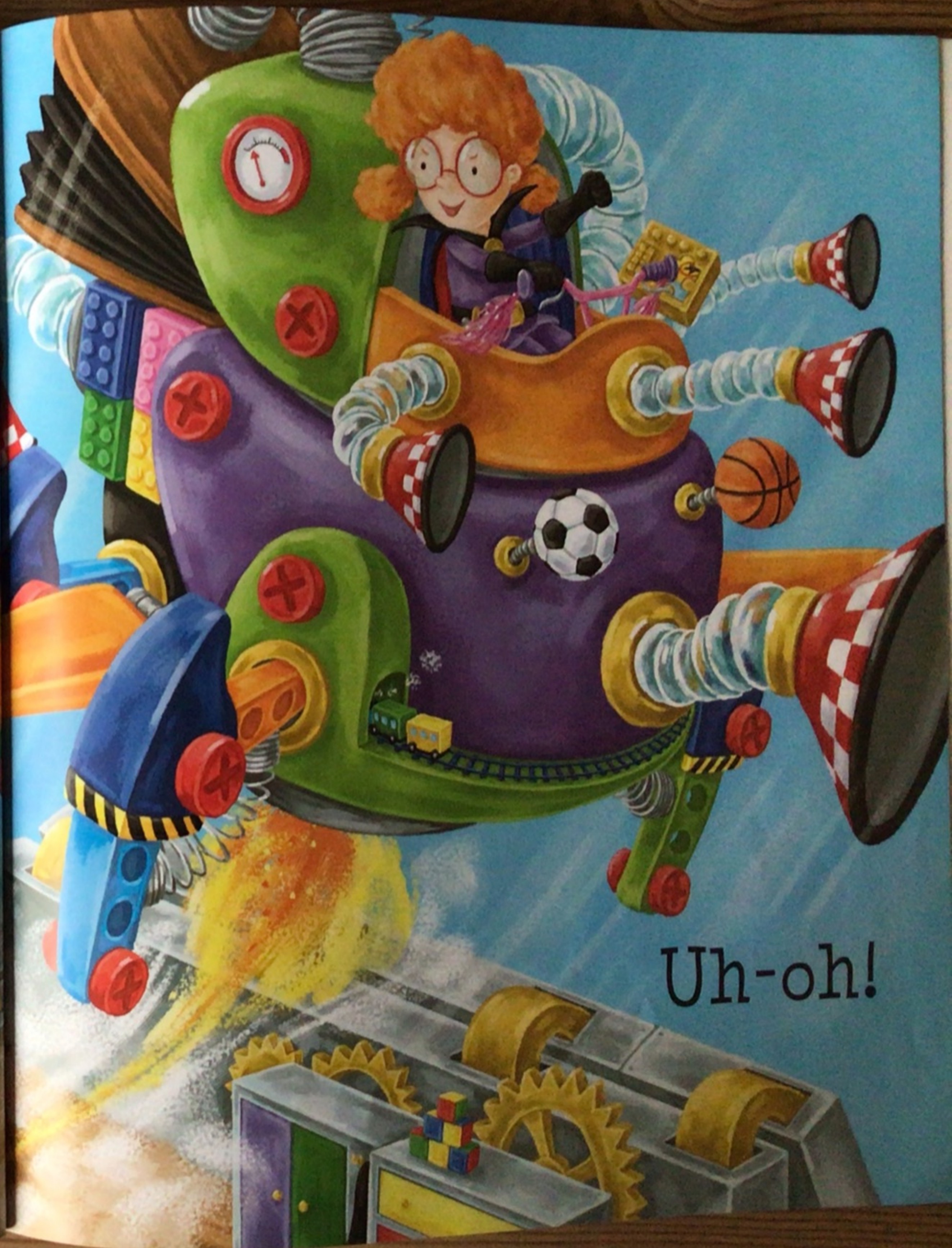
"Actually it's a Flying Game Grabber," says The Collector.
