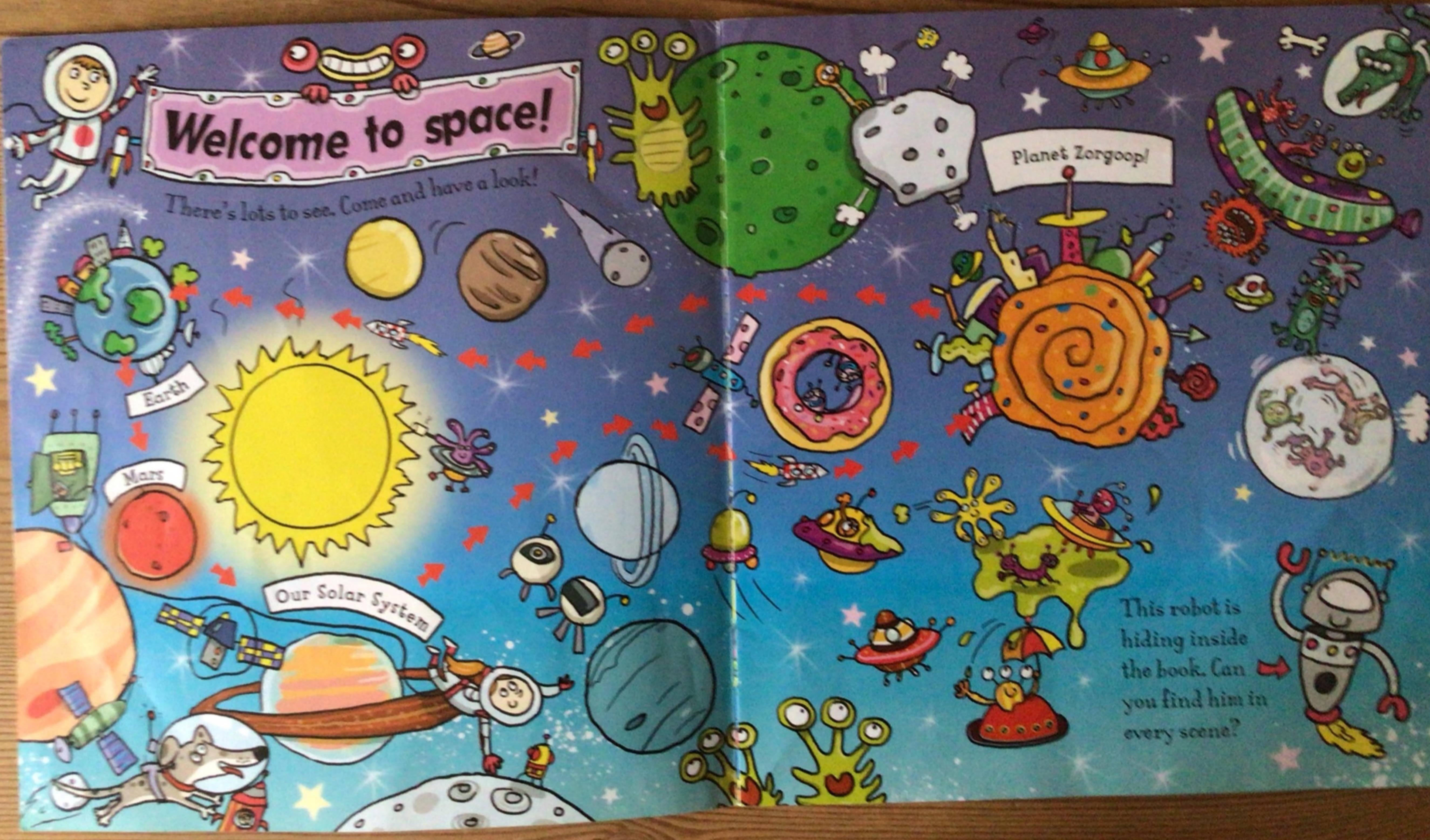

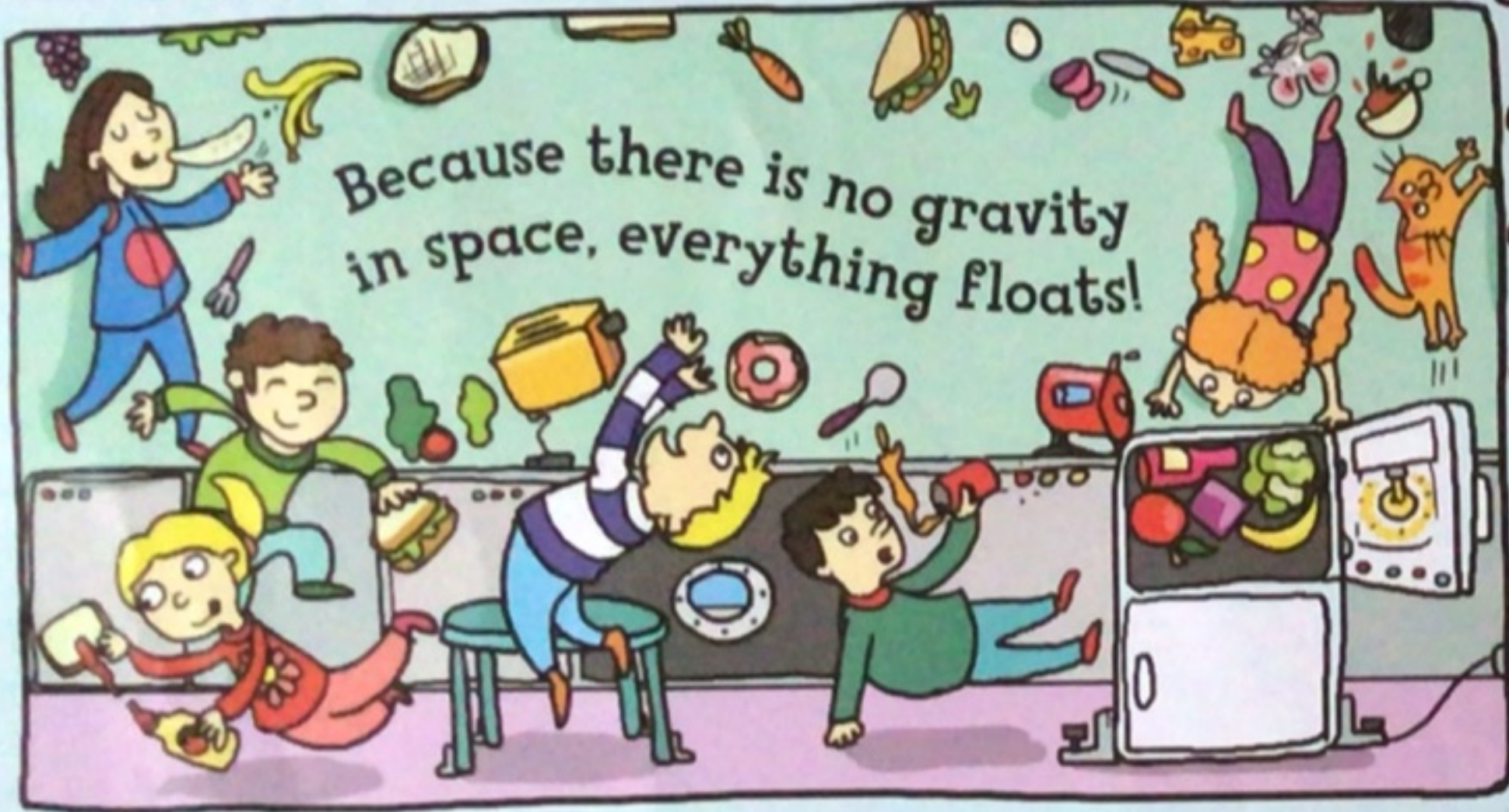

Valentina Tereshkova was the first woman in space in 1963. She was 26 years old.

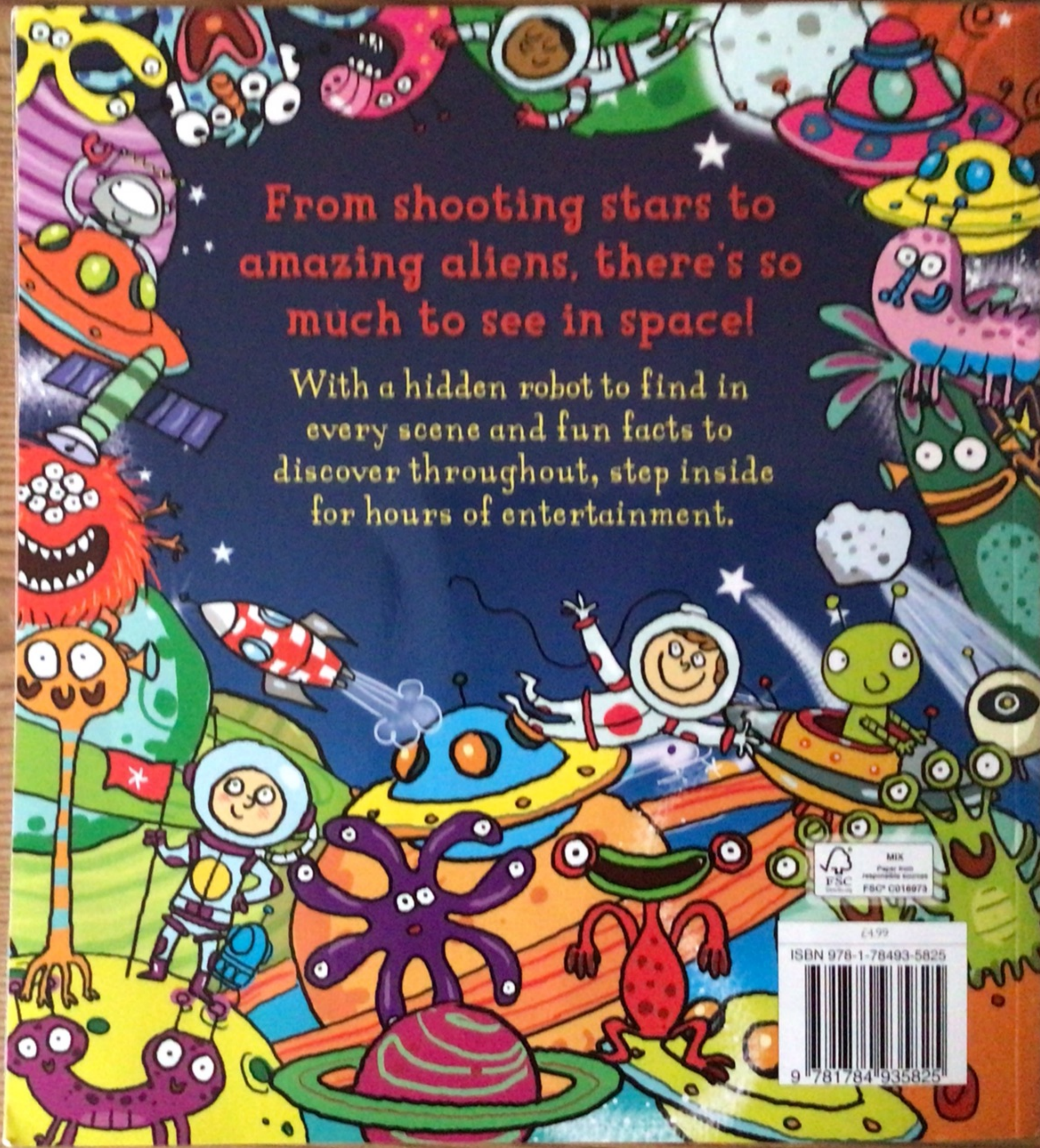
One of the first animals in space was a Russian dog called Laika.
