
Old buildings can be knocked down by wrecking balls and diggers, or blown up using explosives.




The world's tallest crane is also the strongest. It can lift a load the weight of 12 blue whales over 50 storeys high.



Did you know?




It takes just 15 seconds for a 30-storey building to be demolished using explosives.

The Chrysler Building, a 77-floor skyscraper in New York, USA, was built very quickly. Four floors were completed every week.
