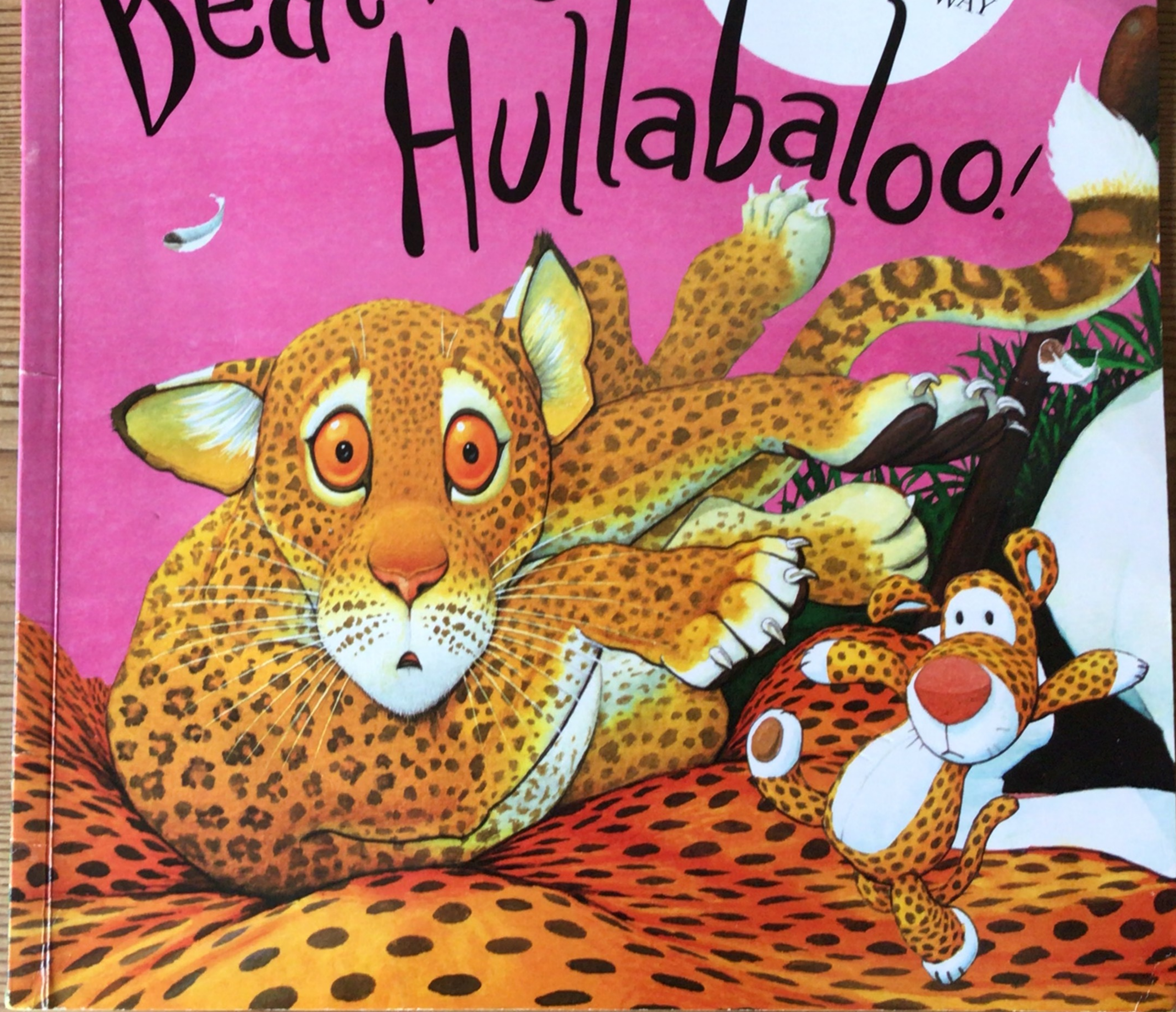

HHHRRR-ZZZ!



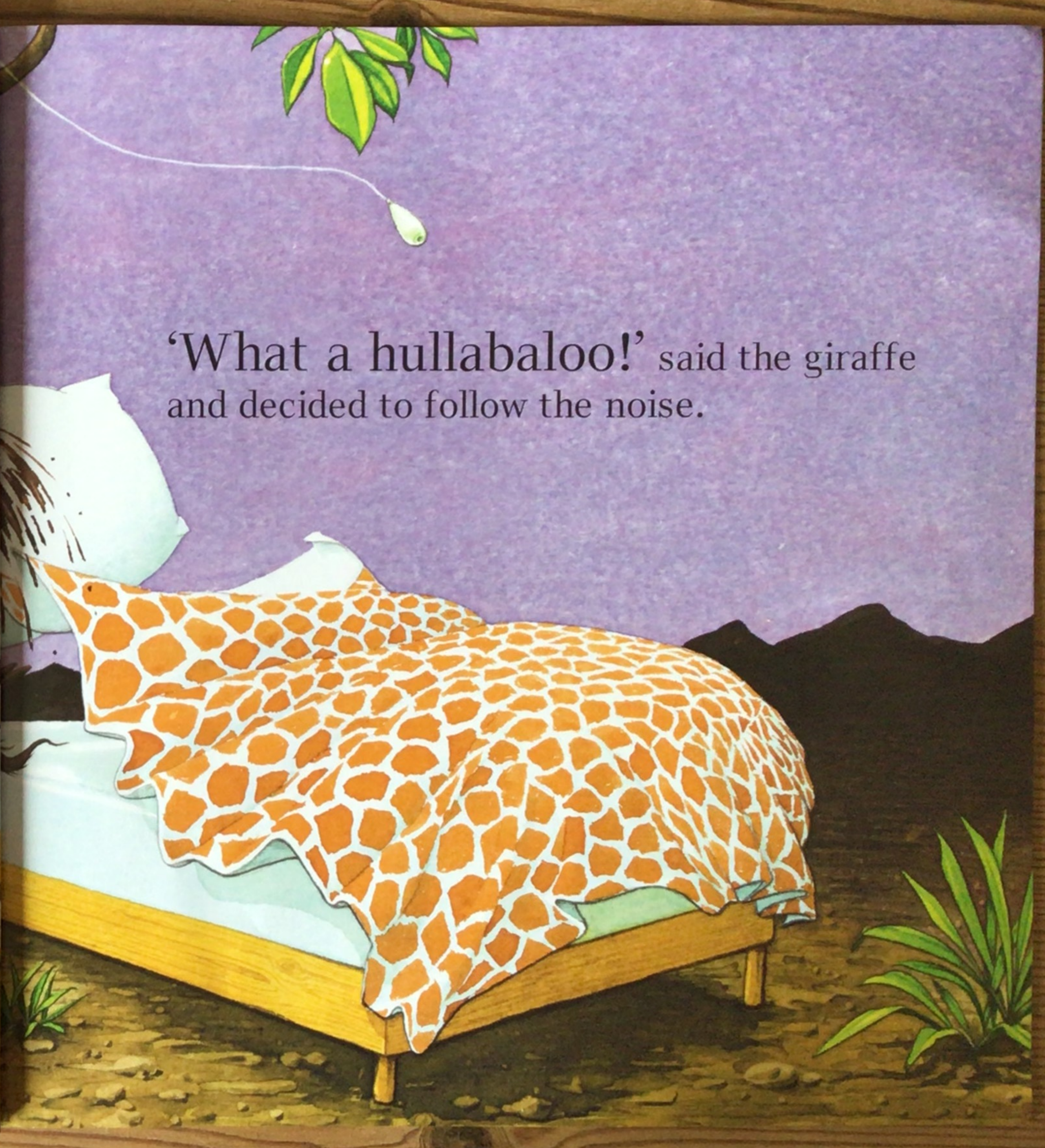
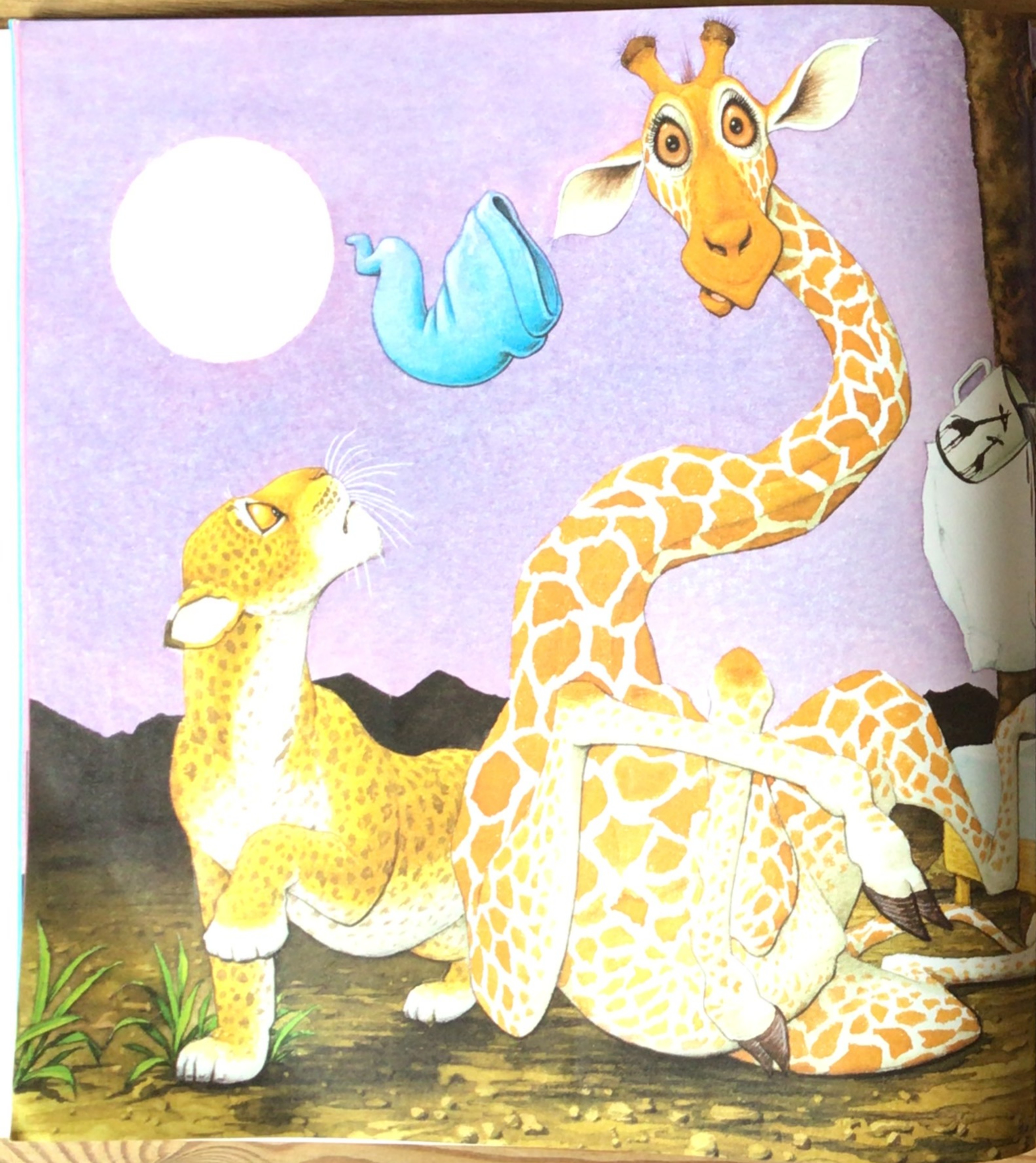
'What a hullabaloo!' said the leopard
and decided to follow the noise.




Along the way the leopard

to follow the noise.

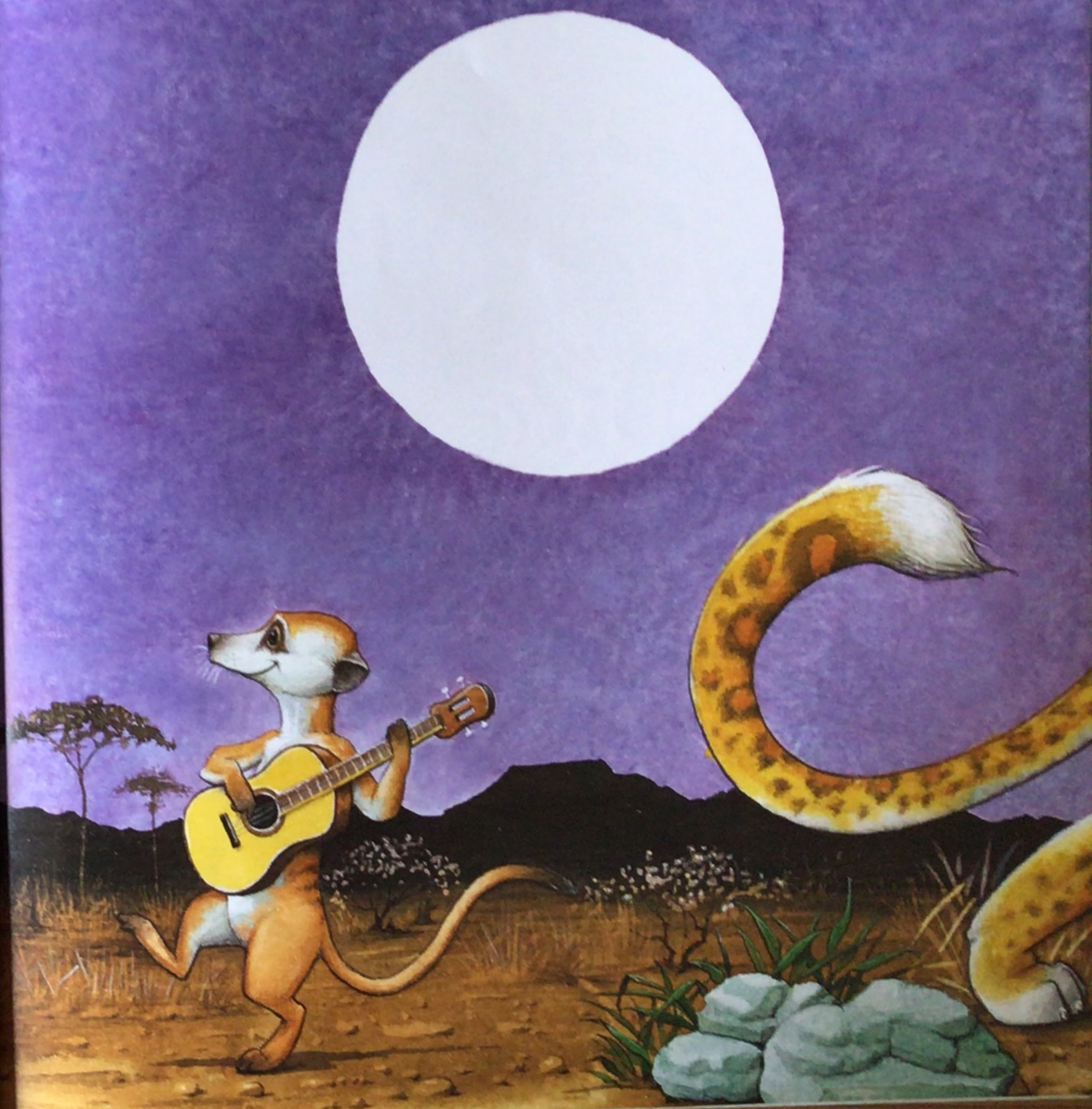


The three animals followed the noise to check out all the fuss and discover the source of this bedtime din, this clamour, this hubbub, this rumpus.

But a tiny shrew, wearing a pink tutu, snoring her head off very loudly.

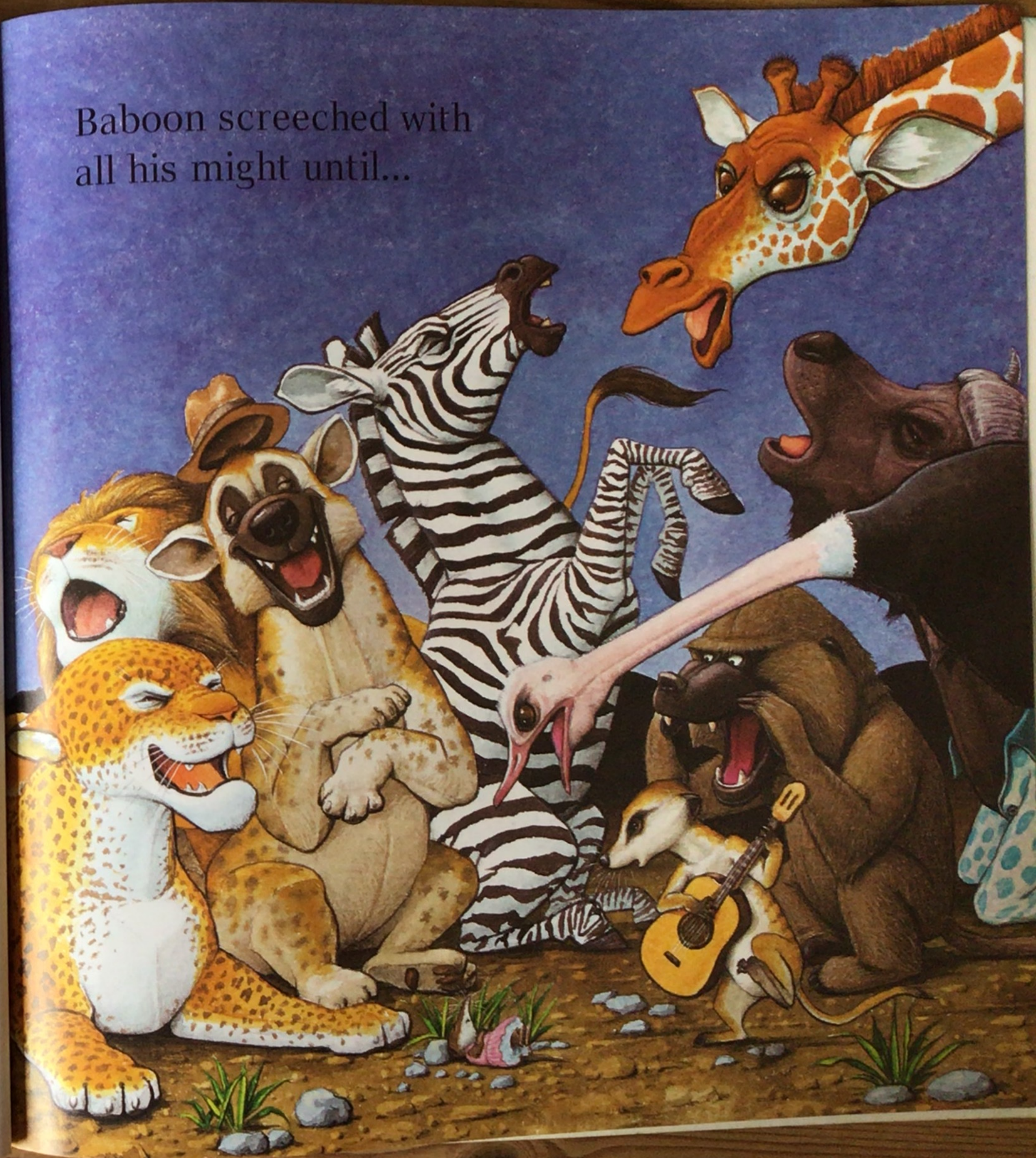

A BIG SURPRISE!



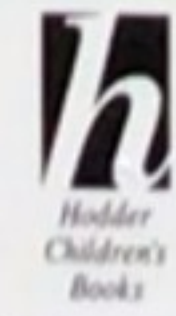
