blue socks, blue shoes,



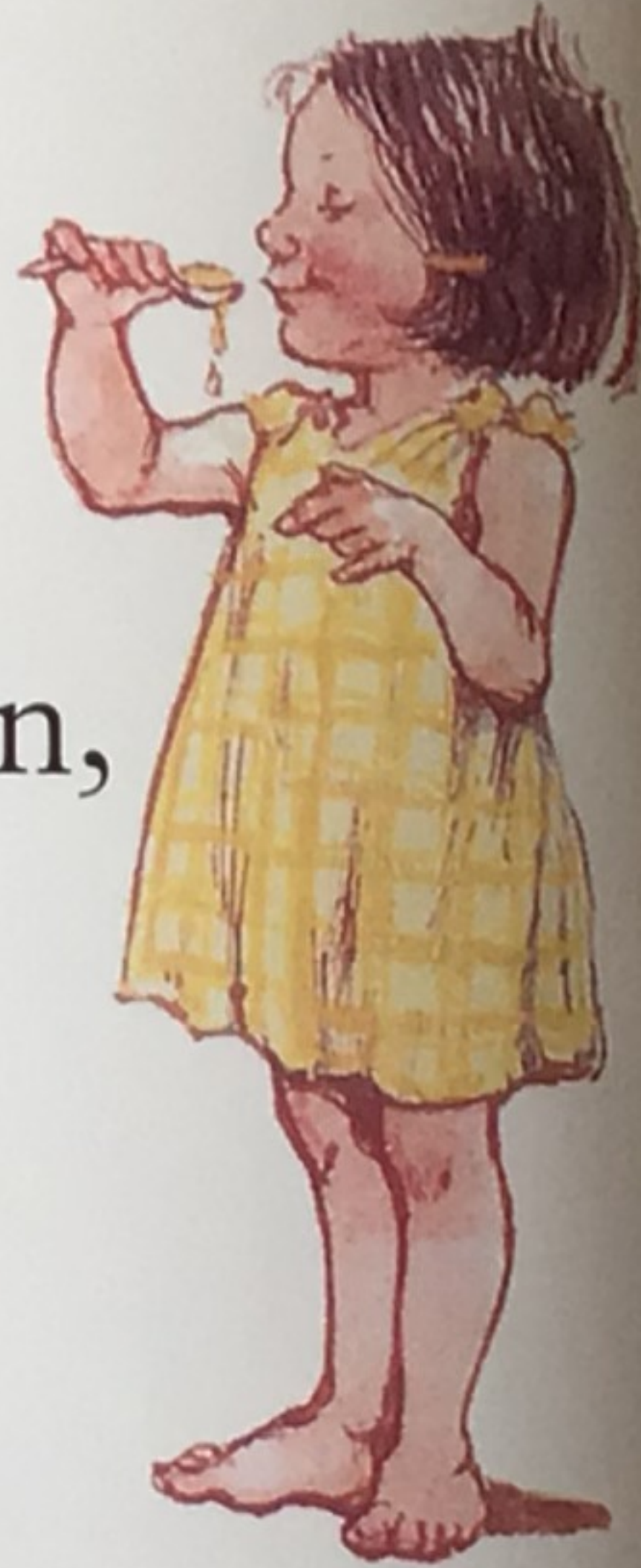
Blue plate, blue mug,
