#### HOW A PARENT CAN 'REPORT A CHILD PROTECTION CONCERN' WITHIN

#### THE SCHOOL

Any parent can report a concern regarding the safety of their child or any other child

#### Step 1

"I have a concern about my child (or any other child)"



#### Step 2

"I can talk to the class teacher of this child"



#### Step 3

"If I am still concerned, I can talk to Mrs Pearson, the Designated

Teacher"

(or if Mrs Pearson is unavailable, Mr Higginson, the Deputy Designated Teacher)

OR

I can speak to the principal (Mr Heggarty)



#### Step 4

"If I am still concerned, I can talk or write to Mrs Moyra Hunter, Chairperson of the Board of Governors & Safeguarding Governor"
