Budgets Classes for 2024-25

Budgets for all schools, including Toreagh, are challenging. It is impossible for most schools to live within their budget allocation anymore. In the budget there is money to allow Principal Release 2 days per week (74 days). This year the total was 28 days, covered by Mrs Ellison. Miss Morrow also covered 20 days sickness for other teachers. By doing this, we saved money and had a much higher carry- over than expected, which has helped moving into 2024-25. It will not be possible to continue this arrange due to class sizes.

The Governors must continue to monitor the school budget in line with advice from EA and the Department of Education. The budget will be reviewed at the end of the financial year.

Free School Meals & Uniform Grant

Education Minister Paul Givan has announced an interim change to the eligibility criteria for families applying for free school meals and uniform grants for the 2024/25 academic year.

The annual net earnings threshold that applies to free school meals and uniform grants applicants who are in receipt of Universal Credit has been raised from £14,000 to £15,000.

The increased threshold will take effect from when the Education Authority (EA) portal, EA Connect, opens on 18 June 2024 for applications and is an interim rise pending completion of the ongoing review of the eligibility criteria for free school meals and uniform grants.
