We also have an in-house Benefits Advisor, who can conduct benefit checks, fill in benefit application and renewal forms and offer free and impartial advice. Not forgetting our Preloved School Uniform Scheme which is available all year round.

#### HOW OUR SERVICE OPERATES

Our service will be available to accepted members for either a four or a twelve-week basis, depending on client circumstances. Successful applicants will be invited for an initial entry interview to set up their membership. All clients will be offered a free benefit check throughout their membership period with clients availing of a short check in review on weeks 4 and 8, along with an exit interview on week 12. We would encourage all clients to attend at least one of our in-house workshops.

#### HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

There is a one-off membership fee of £5. Then a weekly shop will cost £5 with members able to choose up to 15 items for £5 per week.
