The students did not participate in the 'Yes Campaign' sustainability activity this year but did have a session on sustainability.

Feedback from the students on how the programme supported them most is as follows:

- Gained a better understanding of the world of work 90%
- Improved soft skills our session was Teamwork 80%
- Improved focus about life after school 80%
- Increased self-confidence 70%
- Gained a better understanding of sustainability 60%

60% of students said that participation in the programme changed the way they think about school, while **40%** said that it did not.
