3rd years celebrated their achievements at a special graduation ceremony with family and staff. Students received their JCSP Final Profile Statements—well done to all!

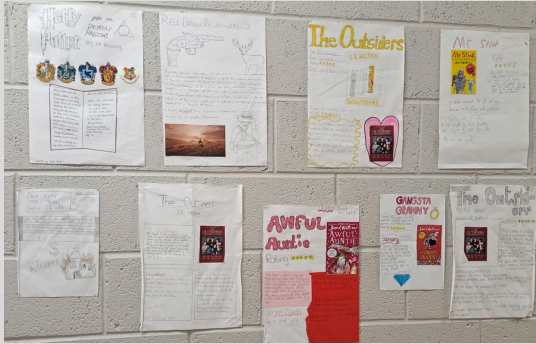
