Communicating with Parents/Carers

As you know we strive to ensure our communication is as clear as possible. However, recently it has become clear that SEESAW is not working for general communication. We know some parents, especially those who have more than one child in the school, find it difficult to locate previous messages on Seesaw. As a result, we are currently reviewing alternative ways to communicate to make it as easy as possible for families. Until we come up with a longer-term solution we plan to do the following:

From January will be changing the way we use Seesaw and the School Newsletter.

Seesaw - We will no longer use Seesaw for whole school messages. Teachers will send messages to their class only.

Newsletter - We will send the newsletter out on a more regular basis. The newsletter will be available on the school website, and we advise that you print/keep a copy on hand for reminders.

We will continue to use Facebook and the Teacher2Parents messaging service as we investigate alternative services.

Christmas Dinner Day

We will have a non-uniform day on Friday 13th December when pupils will have their Christmas dinner. Pupils can wear Christmas Jumpers or something they already have at home and "Christmas-ize" it!
