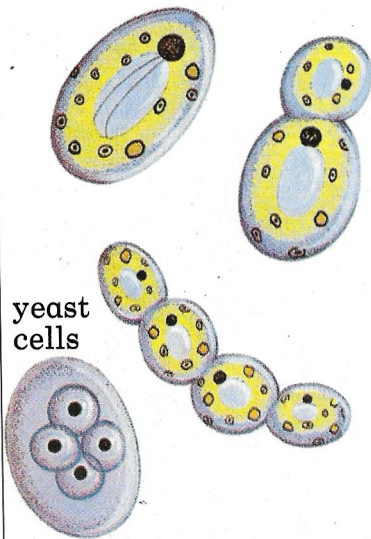

How bread is made

The pictures and writing on these pages come from a book all about different kinds of fungi. When we think of fungi we usually think of mushrooms. *Yeast* doesn't look like a mushroom or a toadstool, but it is a type of fungus that is very useful.



yeast cells

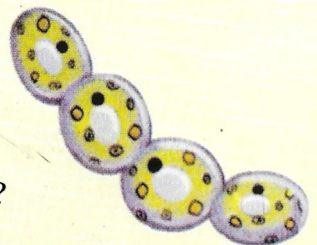
Another useful fungus is called yeast. Yeast is used to make bread and to make beer. The picture shows tiny yeast cells. Yeast cells feed on sugar and on starch. As they feed, they give off a gas called carbon dioxide.

Bakers make dough for bread from flour, sugar, milk and water.

There is a lot of starch in flour.

If the dough were cooked it would be flat and hard.

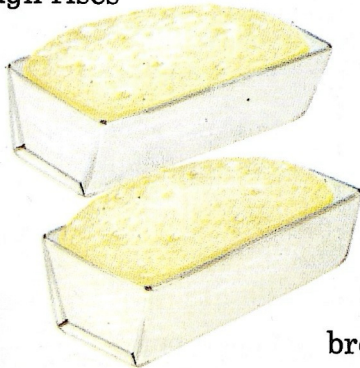
But the baker adds yeast to the dough.

The yeast feeds on the sugar and starch, and gives off bubbles of carbon dioxide.

These bubbles are trapped in the dough and make it rise.

When it is cooked, the bread is soft and light.

dough rises

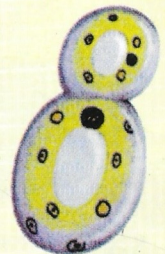
