Uimhearthacht/Numeracy

- Ask the children to count to 10 in Irish. Begin to ask them what number comes after 5? What number comes before 4? Use visuals and your hands to help explain before and after.
- Go over all colours in Irish and English. Ask the children if they remember what the colour of the month is. Look for colours in the garden- flowers, colour of the houses and cars.
- Look for the oval shape and try to spot shapes in your house and outdoors in the garden.

The children can go on a **colour and shape hunt** inside or outside the house.

- Go over the visual sounds with the children and try to find items indoors/outdoors

Where is the ball? The ball is <u>under</u> the car. Where is the cup sitting? The cup is siting **on** the table.

What is your brother/sister/ mother doing? he/she is sitting outside.
