The Beatitudes Sensory Bottle

Create a sensory bottle to remind you of the Beatitudes which we find in 'The Sermon on the Mount' from Matthew, Chapter 5.















Instructions...

- 1) Take an empty plastic bottle.
- 2) Put a penny, a feather, one drop of blue food colouring or blue paint, some rice and water, some sequin or jewels, a red ribbon, some glitter, an elastic band and a yellow pom-pom inside.
- 3) Fill the bottle with more water if needed.
- 4) Put lid on the bottle and secure with cello tape.
- 5) Read Beatitudes below while looking at your sensory bottle.



Seeing the crowds, he went onto the mountain. And he sat down and was joined by his disciples. Then he began to speak. This is what he taught them:

Penny: How happy are the poor in spirt: theirs is the kingdom of Heaven,
Feather: Happy are the gentle: they shall have the earth for their heritage,
Blue water: Happy are those who mourn: they shall be comforted,
Rice & Water: Happy are those who hunger and thirst for what is right: they
shall be satisfied,

Sequin or Jewels: Happy the merciful: they shall have mercy shown them,

Red Ribbon: Happy are the pure in heart: they shall see God,

Glitter: Happy the peacemakers: they shall be called sons of God,

Elastic band: Happy are those who are persecuted in the cause of right: theirs is the kingdom of Heaven,

Yellow pom-pom: Happy are you when people abuse you and persecute you and speak all kinds of calumny against you on my account. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven; this is how they persecuted the prophets before you.
