Count on/back in halves and quarters

Fractions of quantities

e.g. $\frac{1}{5}$ of 25 or $\frac{1}{3}$ of £30

Division in written calculation

Short division
98 ÷ 7 becomes
$$\begin{array}{r} 14 \\ 7 \overline{) 98} \\ \underline{7} \\ 28 \\ \underline{28} \\ 0 \end{array}$$

Answer: 14

Subtracting 4 digit numbers

$$\begin{array}{r} 3412 \quad 4000 \\ -1324 \quad -3264 \end{array}$$

Multiplying by 10 (answers within 9999)
