- (Username will be displayed in a document under Learning at Home on Website) (Password = Bunscoil20).
- In the Launch pad (right hand side) they should click on both 'Newsdesk' and 'Seomra Nuachta'. These are Apps for both English and Irish reading practice.
- Continued reading of any books in the house
