I scoil an Droichid, cuirtear sainoideachas nuálach uileghabhálach ar fáil dár bpáistí trí mheán na Gaeilge. Cruthaítear scoil ina ndéantar ceiliúradh ar dhínit agus iomlánú an pháiste fríd pháirtíocht pobail. Trasnáimid droichid le nascanna a dhéanamh le pobal oirdheisceart na cathrach agus i gcéin le foghlaim fad an saoil a bhláthú.

Aidhmeanna na Scoile

1. Is Scoil lán-Ghaeilge í Scoil/Naíscoil an Droichid agus is é príomhaidhm na scoile oideachas bunscolaíochta trí mheán na Gaeilge a chur ar fáil do pháistí idir trí bliana agus bliain déag d'aois.
2. Tá sé mar aidhm ag an Scoil / Naíscoil caoinfhulaingt agus comhthuisct a chothú i gcúrsaí creidimh, polaitíochta, cultúir agus teanga. Is rún linn go mbeidh tuiscint ag an pháiste ar a dtír féin agus ar an domhan a bhfuil muid beo ann.
3. D'éascair Scoil / Naíscoil an Droichid as an eacht a rinne tuismitheoirí dheisceart agus oirthear Bhéal Feirste tumoideachas Gaeilge a thabhairt chuig a gceantar féin agus is trí iarrachtaí agus rannpháirteachas na dtuismitheoirí a leanfaidh forbairt an tumoideachais ar aghaidh. The School Day

Primary 1/Náiscoil

School hours

Primary 1 & 2 -9.00am – 2.00pm

Primary 3 – 7 – 9.00am – 3.00pm

Nursery hours :

9.00am – 1.30pm

Lunch: 12pm – 12:45pm

If your child is coming to school late you must accompany them and ensure you speak to the school secretary. You are responsible for ensuring your child gains access to his/her class.

Dinner

Every Nursery Child is encouraged to eat a hot healthy dinner everyday. Our school dinners are prepared in the nearby St Michael's School and transported to the school where they will be served in the School's own dining area.

Break-time

Each class has an informal break to allow the children to relax from class-work and to have the opportunity to use the toilet. **We ask that you give your child a piece of fruit or a yogurt for break each day.**

After the school day

We ask you to collect your child from the school entrance area. An adult must collect the child and if someone different will be picking your child up please let the teacher know. Always collect your child on time as the teachers have other responsibilities. For children who travel home on the mini-bus it is essential that someone collect them from the pick-up point.

Taisteal

Tá bus **Translink** ar fáil do pháiste óna Maragaidh agus an Trá Ghearr. Imíonn an bus seo ar 8.40rn ar costas £1. Is féidir Smartcard a cheannacht a thugann lacáiste ar gach thuras. Tá bus na scoile ar fáil do pháistí ó Thuaisceart na cathrach. Baile na Feá, Rosetta agus an Trá Ghearr. Fágfaidh an bus na páistí seo ar ais ag áiteanna ar eith agus caithfidh duine ainmithe a bheith ann chun iad a thógáil.

Tá níos mó eolais ar fáil ón Polasaí Bhus.

Tinreamh and Poncúlacht

Ceann de na fachtóirí is mó a rachaidh i bhfeidhm ar oideachas do pháiste ná an ráta tinrimh a bheas aige, go háirithe sa tumoideachas Gaeilge. Is cuma faoin leibheál ábaltachta deánfaidh gach páiste a thagann chun na scoile go rialta agus a chomhlíonann an obair a thugtar dóibh dul chun cinn. Nuair atá leanbh tinn seal is furast ag an mhúinteoir deileáil leis nó go mbíonn a fhios aige cad é atá cailte ag an leanbh ach do leanbh a chailleann lá anseo 'is ansúid go rialta is doiligh modhnóireacht a dhéanamh ar an obair agus is neamhrialta an dul chun cinn a dhéanfas an leanbh sin. Tà sé suas duitse mar thuismitheoir dearcadh dearfach i léith dul chun na scoile a chothú ón chéad lá i Rang a hAon.

Is amhlaidh an scéal le poncúlacht. Ba chóir do gach páiste bheith ar scoil roimh 9.00 r.n. réidh le toiseacht ar an lá scoile. Is cur isteach ar gach duine é páistí ag siúl isteach i lár ceachta.

Tinneas

I gcás tinnis a mhaireann níos mó ná trí lá is gá nóta dochtúra/mínte a chur chuig an scoil. Deánfaidh scairt gútháin i gcásanna eile.

Imeacht roimh dheireadh an lae

Caithfear teagbháil a dhéanamh leis an oifig má tá ar thuismitheoir leanbh a thabhairt amach on scoil i rith am scoile no teagmhail a dhéanamh linn roimh ré más féidir, i gcás coinne atá socraithe.

Transport

A **Translink bus** is available for the children from Short Strand and the Markets. This bus leaves at 8:40am each day and the cost is £1. However a SmartCard can be purchased which gives a discount on each journey.

The School mini-bus is available to children from the North of the City, Ballynafeigh and Rosetta. The Mini-bus will transport children home to these areas as well as the Short Strand and the Markets. The bus will leave the children at designated places and the **must** be collected by an adult.

The school's **Bus Policy** will give more details about bus arrangements .

Attendance and Punctuality

One of the most significant factors that will influence your child's performance in school will be his rate of attendance, especially in immersion type education. Regardless of ability level, all children who consistently attend school and complete the work given to them will make progress. If a child is ill for a period of time this can be handled quite easily by the class teacher as she is aware of the work the child has missed, but when short periods are missed frequently, the child's work becomes very difficult to monitor and progress becomes erratic. It is up to you as a parent to instill a positive attitude towards attending school from the first day in Primary One. Punctuality is of the same importance. Every child should be in school and ready to begin their day's work at 9.30a.m. It is very disruptive to all in class if a child arrives in during a lesson.

Sickness

In the case of an illness which lasts longer than three days it is necessary to send a doctors/explanatory note into school. In other cases a phone call will suffice.

Leaving before the end of the day

Permission must be sought before removing a child from school during school hours. If you must bring your child out during this time, where possible, let the school know of appointments beforehand.

2. Gan costas a ghearradh i léith leabhair, áiseanna no trealamh atá curtha ar fáil i gcomhair leis an churaclam coitianta agus oideachas cráifeach.

3. Costas a ghearradh i léith lóistín ag éirí as ghníomhaíocht taobh istigh d'uaireanta scoile, mar shampla turas chuig anonad oideachasúil.

4. Costas a ghearradh d'imeachtaí roghnacha ag titim amach taobh amuigh d'uaireanta scoile.

Is féidir le Bord na nGobharnóirí costas a ghearradh ar thuismitheoirí as ucht damáiste a dheántar do threalamh na scoile mar gheall ar dhrochiompar dalta.

Charges

It is the policy of Scoil an Droichid Board of Governors:

1. To provide free education for all and to ensure that all activities organized during school hours are made available to all pupils.
2. To provide free of charge all books, resources and equipment required in connection with the common curriculum or religious education.
3. To charge for board and lodging on residential visits taking place within school hours, for example a field trip to an educational centre.
4. To charge for activities considered as optional extras taking place outside of school hours.
5. To charge for the provision of individual instrumental music tuition.

The Board of Governors may make charges to parents arising from breakages or damage to school property as a result of pupil's misbehaviour.



An Curaclam

Tugtar oideachas chomh leathan agus is féidir, de réir riachtanais an pháiste sna Réimsí Staidéir Churaclam Thuaisceart Eireann, de réir an Achta Um Leasú an Oideachais (TE) 1989. Cuirtear an curaclam ar fáil trí mheán na Gaeilge ach tá an Béarla le teagasc chomh maith ó bhliain 3 ar aghaidh, le go féidir leis an pháiste maireachtáil i sochaí a leagann an luach ar an Bhéarla.

Tugtar aird ar na hachair staidéir seo a leanas:

- Teanga agus Litearthacht -An Ghaeilge agus an Béarla
- Matamaitic agus Uimhearthacht
- An Domhan Domhan Thart Orainn
- Na hEalaíne
- Forbairt Phearsanta agus Comhthuisicint
- Forbairt agus Gluaiseacht Fhisiceach

Riachtanais Speisialta Oideachais

Deántar iarracht buanna achan pháiste a fhorbairt. Aithnítear riachtanais oideachasúla agus tugtar an tacaíocht chuí don pháiste. Tá polasaí an Bhoird i bhfeidhm ag an scoil agus tá seirbhís tacaíochta acu le cuidiú leis an mhúinteoir Ranga. Leanfaidh an scoil líne an chódcleachtais.

Measúnacht

Bítear ag síormheas na páistí le linn an teagaisc agus fríd an obair baile. Tógtar fianaise ó obair ranga ón pháiste agus coinnítear comhad oibre ar gach páiste ina mbíonn samplaí éagsúla oibre a léiríonn an curaclam uilig.

Tugtar tuairisc béil do thuismitheoirí fríd agallamh pearsanta i mí Feabhra agus tuairisc scríofa ar gach páiste i Mí Mheithimh.

Deántar reasúnú ag deireadh eochairchéime de réir Rialacha CCEA agus tugtar leibhéal sa dá ábhar — Matamaitic agus Gaeilge, ag deireadh R4 agus Béarla fosta ag R7. Deántar modhnóireacht air seo lasmuigh den scoil.

The Curriculum

The children receive as broad and balanced an education as possible according to their needs. They are taught the subjects of the Areas of Study of the Northern Ireland Curriculum under the terms of the Education Reform Order (NI) 1989. The curriculum is delivered through the medium of Irish but English is also taught as it is the predominant language of the society in which the child exists.

The following areas of study are delivered:

- Language & Literacy — Irish; English
- Mathematics & Numeracy
- The World Around Us
- The Arts (Art/Music/PE)
- Personal Development and Mutual Understanding
- Physical Development and Movement

Special Needs Education

Every effort is made to develop each child's talents. Special Educational Needs are recognized and appropriate support is given to the child. The

BELB policy on Special Educational Needs is in place in school and the outside services are available to us when required. The school will follow the guidelines laid down by the Code of Practice 1998.

Assessment and Reporting

The children are continuously assessed during teaching and through homework. Evidence is collected from class-work and a file of all the children's work containing samples from every area of the curriculum is kept throughout the year.

Personal interviews are held in February to inform the parents of their child's progress and a written report is sent out at the end of June.

Formal assessment takes place at the end of Key Stage 1 in accordance with CCEA rules and levels in Mathematics and Irish are given to each child at the end of Year 4 and 7. English is also assessed at the end of P7. These results are monitored by CCEA.

School Discipline

We aim to create an environment that will foster the development of the child and nurture the child's sense of self-discipline and self-respect. To make sure that our aim is fulfilled, the children are expected to comply with the following simple rules of behaviour:

- Be respectful of all members of the school community — pupils, teachers, ancillary staff and visitors
- Be well mannered
- Be on time for school
- Show pride in the School, the site and all school property
- Play fairly, avoid fighting
- Wear school uniform
- Always walk on pathways, corridors and in class
- Practice good manners at meal-times
- Ensure no litter is evident anywhere in the school environment
- Comply with the requests and instructions of all members of school staff in a mannerly way.

Cúram Tréadach

Tá éiteas na scoile bunaithe ar an chaidreamh cairdiúl idir an fhoireann, na páistí agus na thuismitheoirí. Creidimid nach mbíonn neart go cur le chéile agus mar fhoireann táimid i dtuilleamaí ar a chéile ó thaobh saineolais agus buanna pearsanta de. Aithnítear nach beag an tionchar atá ag tuismitheoirí in oideachas a gcuid páistí agus bheirtear iarracht próiséis na scoile a roinnt leo. Táthar ag súil le bhur dtacaíocht.

Polasaí Frith-thromaíocht

Mar chuid de Pholasaí Frith-thromaíocht iarramid ar ghach pháiste culaith scoile a chaitheamh agus is ionann sin agus briste bnó sciorta dubh ghorm, t-leine dubhghorm agus brigan dubha. Ní chaithear bróga reatha ach amháin ag am spóirt.

Complaints about the Curriculum

If a parent is not satisfied with any aspect of the curriculum offered to his child he is invited to express his concern through (i) the class teacher with permission from the Principal; (ii) the Principal; (iii) the Board of Governors.

Pastoral Care

The school ethos is founded on a good relationship between staff, children and parents. We believe that there is strength in unity and as a staff we are dependent on sharing one another's expertise and talents.
