

CHILD PROTECTION

Code of Behaviour for Pupils

All members of the school community have the right to be able to work and play in a clean, calm, orderly, secure and safe environment. In doing so they also have the right to be treated with respect.

In the classroom pupils will show respect for others by participating in activities in a manner which does not disrupt the learning of others. All children should :-

- Pay attention when the teacher is talking
- Put up their hand to answer instead of shouting out
- Always be polite and mannerly in class
- Avoid distracting or annoying other pupils during lessons
- Collect necessary equipment at start of lesson if possible
- Keep snacks and drinks for their break
- Try to avoid leaving the room during lessons to visit the toilet
- except pupils in the Foundation Stage : P1 and P2
- Tidy away materials when asked to do so
- Make sure their classroom area is clean and tidy
- Stay in the classroom unless given permission to leave by the teacher
- Leave mobile phones at home

All pupils should be punctual and well prepared for their curricular activities.

They will be reminded to :-

- Come equipped for the school day - books, PE kit, swimming kit etc
- Leave unnecessary items at home
- Leave expensive toys/games/equipment at home
- Attend school regularly and arrive in good time
- Ensure all homework has been completed
- Apologise to the teacher for being late
- Give a reason for arriving late
- Bring a written explanation for absences from school
