Times will be flexible but will take place between 9.00 and 10am.

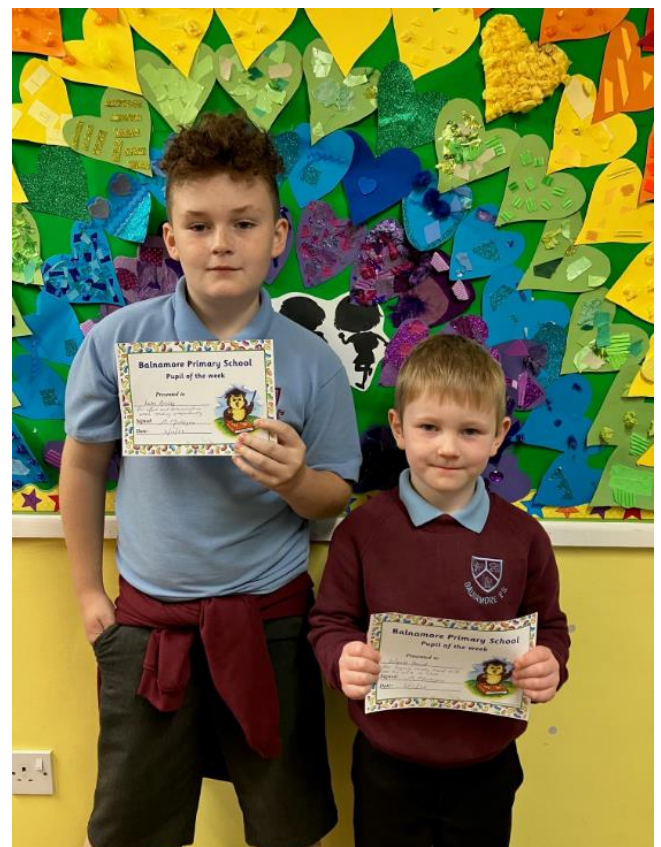


This week's Pupils of the Week are:

Luke in P6 got hers for his effort and determination when reading independently.

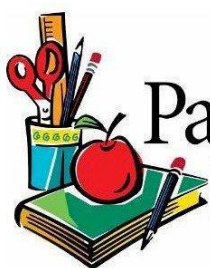

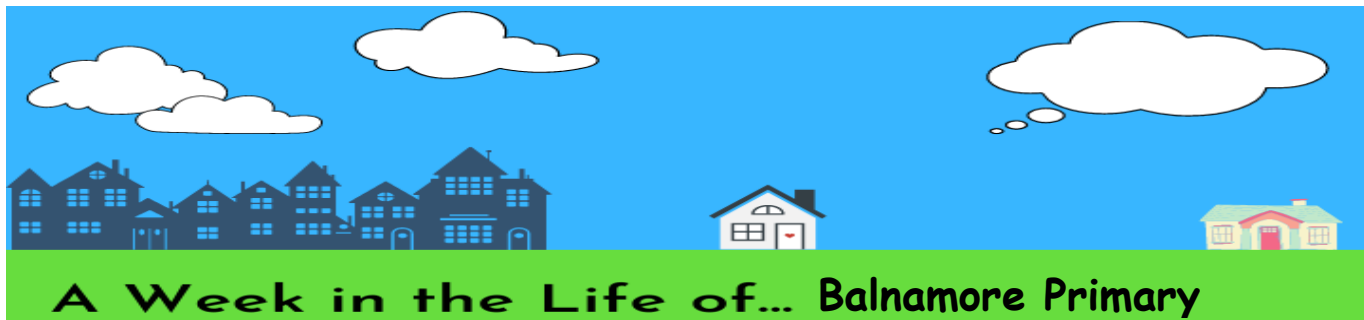

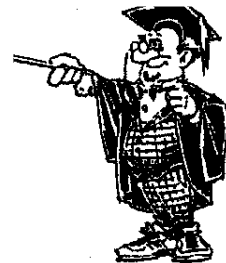
