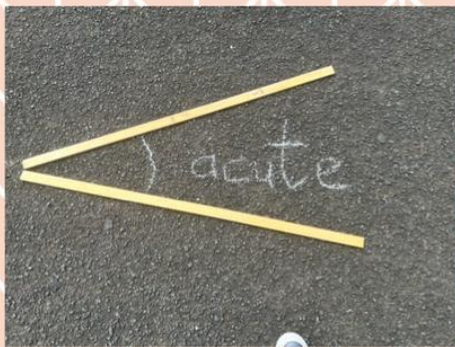


The sun has got his hat on

The first blink of sunshine and it was picnic time in Balamore. Thank you to Joyce and Mandy for packing up and bringing our lunches outside.



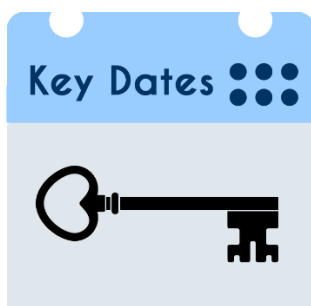
Numeracy Outdoors Exploring angles
