The stall will be available in the Assembly Hall 2.00-3.00pm.






Tuesday was a beautiful day and perfect for Whatever Weather Walkers.

We were delighted to have our lunch outside this week.


The first blink of sunshine and it was picnic time in Balnamore. Thank you to Joyce and Mandy for packing up and
