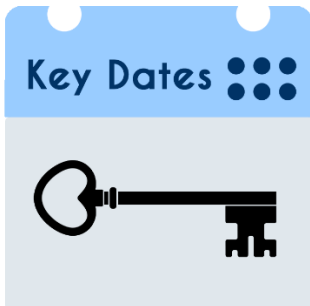

Billy is building a house that has a depth of 8m, height of 10m and a width of 7m. What is the volume of the house?

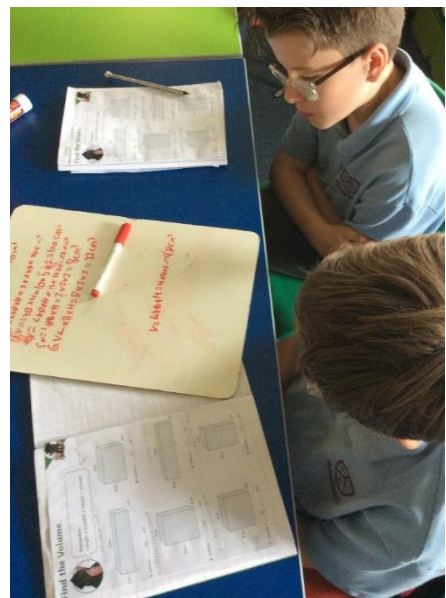
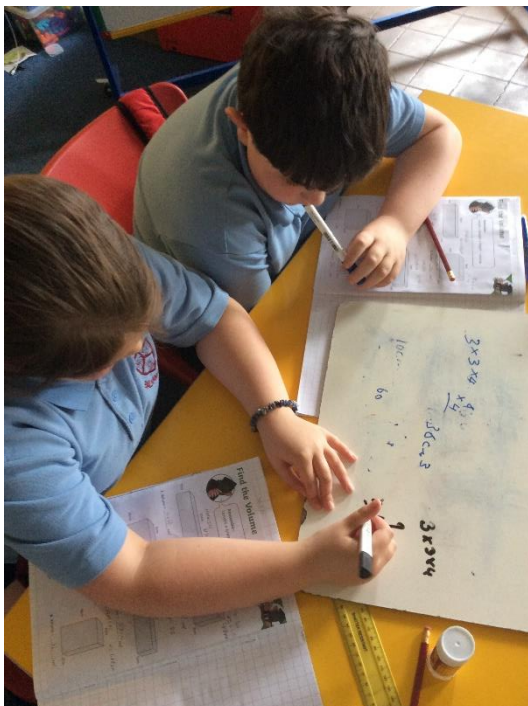
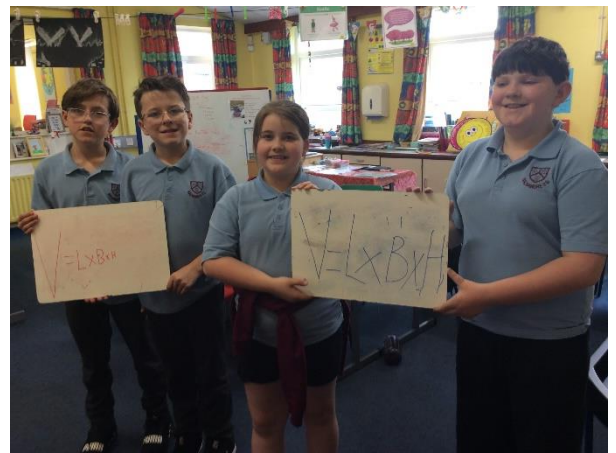
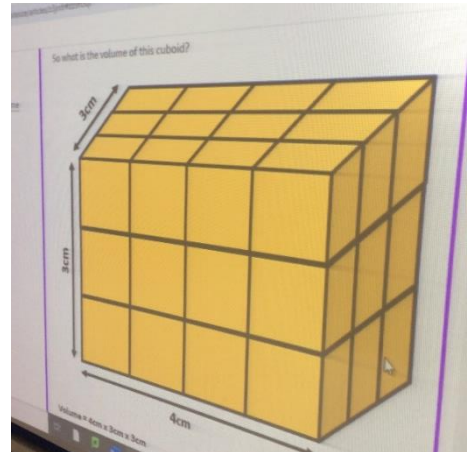
