Anyone who would like to find out more information should feel free to speak to me about this.

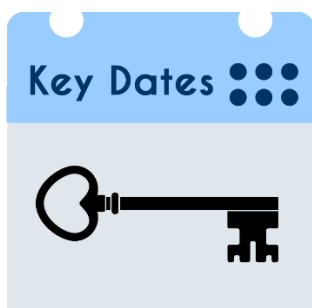

Our P6 children visited Coleraine Grammar School on Monday to experience a day in the life of the school. These are really important opportunities to let our children get a flavour of what these schools have to offer and to inspire them for the year ahead.

The children had a wonderful week in school. In literacy, they have been creating diary entries on Paddington's day at Buckingham Palace. The children have been working on developing a setting using descriptive language and incorporating lots of different punctuation into their diaries. In numeracy, we have been working on doubling numbers within 20, multiplying two and three digit numbers with exchange. The children have also been investigating the life cycle of a butterfly. We looked at the different features of caterpillars and we released them into our school garden to enjoy eating some leaves.
