### **Admissions to the 2021/2022 school year**

#### **Application and Decision Dates for admission to 2021/2022**

The following are the dates applicable for admission to Third Class:

- The school will commence accepting applications for admission on **11th January 2021**
- The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on **1st February 2021**
- The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is **19th February 2021**

The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is **3 weeks**.

**\*Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn**

**Note:** the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.

#### **Number of places being made available in 2021/2022**

The number of places being made available in Third Class is 108.

### **Admissions to the 2020/2021 school year**

#### **Information regarding the admission process for the Intake Group for Third Class for the 2020/2021 school year**

In respect of 2020/2021 school year, the total number of applications for admission received by the school was 117

#### **Breakdown of places allocated for the 20/21 school year:**

- Number of places available: 104
- Number of applications received: 117
- Number of Offers made and accepted under each criteria:
  - Criterion One: Pupils in junior school - 111 places offered, 109 places accepted.
  - Criterion Two: Siblings and stepsiblings of children already enrolled in the school and children resident in the parish\* (the eldest child will have priority in this ranking). – 4 places offered, 4 places accepted
  - Criterion Three: Children of current staff, including ancillary staff (the eldest child will have priority in this ranking) - 1 place offered, 1 place accepted.
