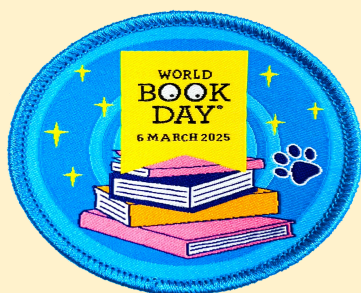

Our school is part of Operation Encompass which is a national scheme that operates jointly between schools and police forces. Operation Encompass is the reporting to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child or young person has experienced domestic abuse. As a school/educational setting we have ensured that a members of our staff, Mr Bogle (designated Teacher for Child Protection) and Mrs Goodman (Deputy Designated Teacher for Child Protection), have been trained in the Operation Encompass procedures allowing us to then use the information that has been shared, in confidence, to support the child/ren in our care.

We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and through Operation Encompass we **will** be able to provide the best possible support to our children.
