Enrolment for Nursery and Primary Schools for September 2025

Online applications for Nursery and Primary places will be open from **10**th **January – 24**th **January 2025**. You will apply via the Parent Portal available at www.eani.org.uk, just as you did last year for Nursery. We have been sharing information on Primary School's Open Days as we receive it, without bias, via Seesaw. It is very important that you apply before 24th January, so your child is considered at Stage 1 of the process.
