Nursery Fund

The total amount for this term's contribution is £55.00, or £5 per week if you wish to pay weekly. This money is used to purchase food for snack, to pay nursery visitors and to buy resources for your child.

We rely heavily on the contribution made by parents to enable us to provide quality resources to support your child's learning, particularly in the face of budget cuts. Please make payments directly into our Nursery Account on a Monday, or on the first day that your child attends school that week, if you are paying weekly and remember to put your child's name as a reference.

We will send reminders through Seesaw at the end of this month for those parents who still owe money from Term 1.

We are hoping that the Christmas Break will have seen a return to wellness for the majority of our children, following a period of lots of illness at the end of last term. Please help us to minimise the spread of childhood illnesses by keeping your child at home if they are unwell. Staff can advise on exclusion periods for different illnesses, so it is important that you let us know if your child is unwell, either via Seesaw or by phonecall.

If your child develops a rash we ask that you please have it identified by your GP, to enable us to advise on exclusion periods where necessary. If you have not had the rash identified we will ask that you keep your child at home until it clears.


