




Literacy


We'll all become confident readers who love books, strong writers who can share our ideas clearly, and we'll see reading and writing helping us in all our lessons.


We're becoming confident mathematicians by practising our number skills every day and learning maths in exciting new ways that help us really understand.

everyday life.


Pupils: Practise your
