Culaith Scoile Nua - New School Uniform

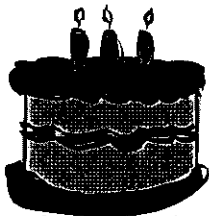

The school will be organising a vote over the coming days re. a possible change to the school uniform, as only 10% of the children are wearing the formal uniform and 90% are wearing the tracksuit for practical and sporting reasons.

The proposal is to get rid of the old uniform and tracksuit and replace it with a new style of school tracksuit- navy leggings with royal blue stripe, light blue polo top and royal blue and navy top with white stripes on the side and school crest. This tracksuit is of superior quality to the current tracksuit. Parents would be advised to purchase 2 tracksuits for practical/hygiene reasons and the new school tracksuits would be available in Grants, as before.
