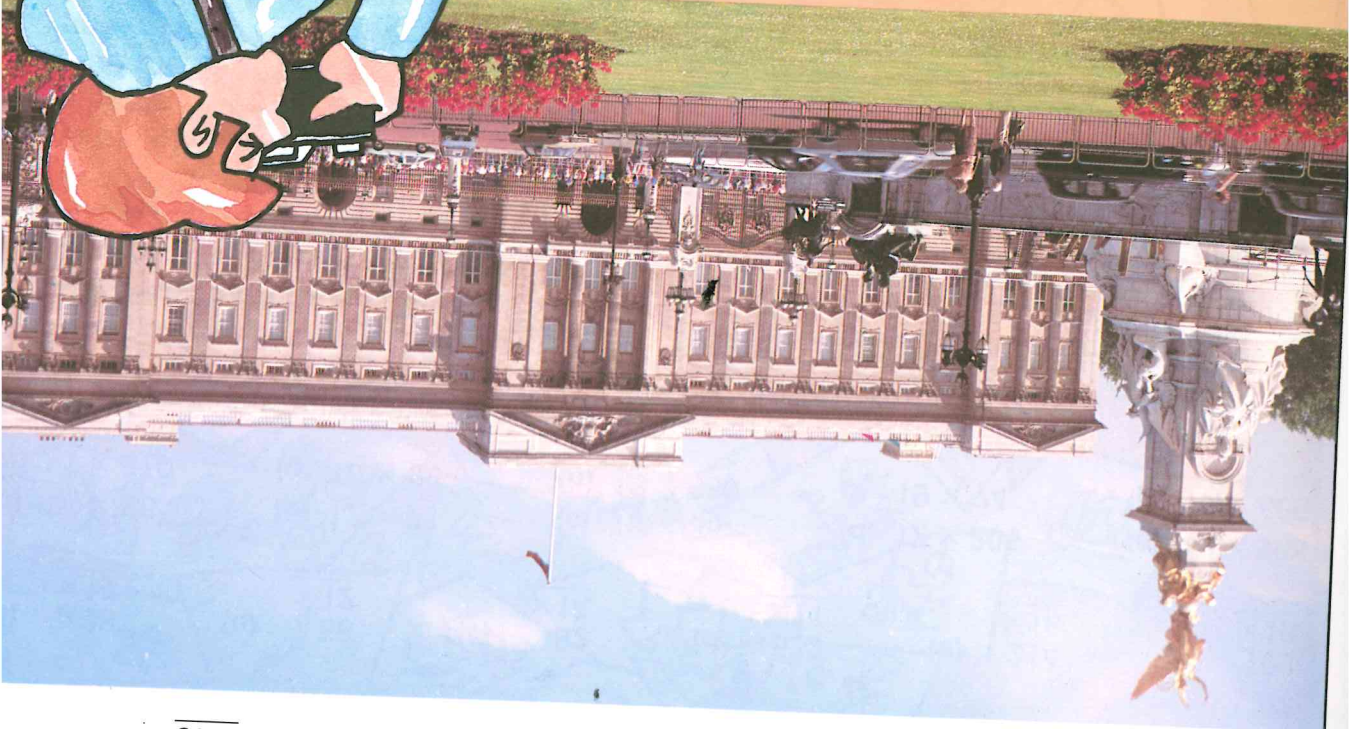


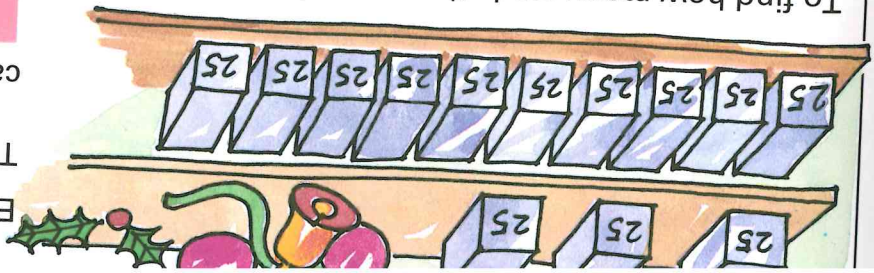
- 2 (a) 19 pupils each paid £75 for a holiday in London.
